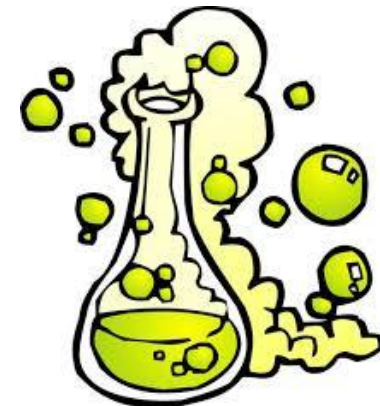

Two Levels- Standard and Accelerated

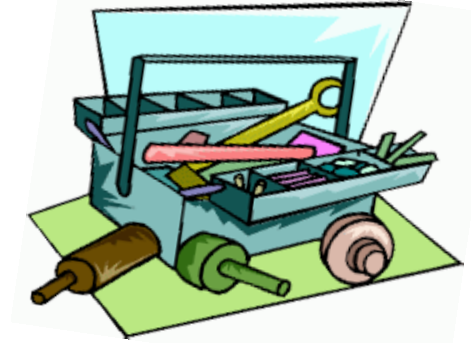

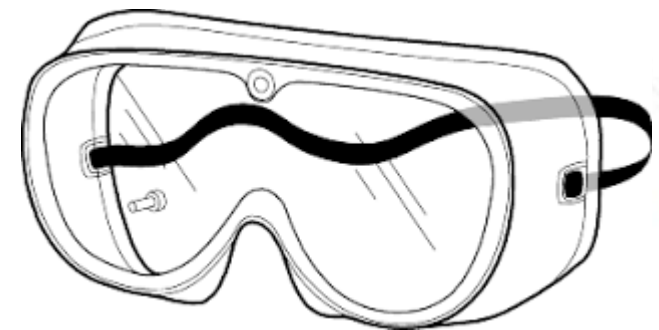

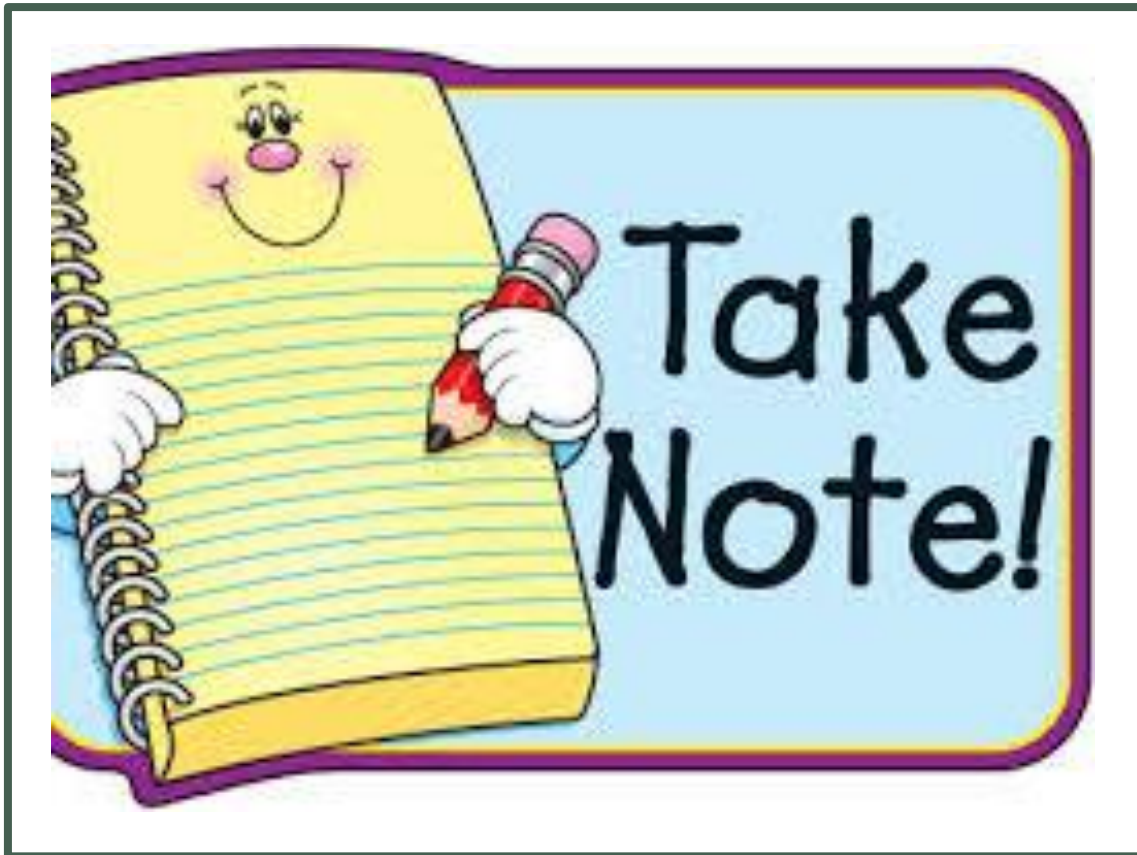
