Unacceptable:

- 2. Shoes: no bare feet (flip flops/crocs included)

Unacceptable Clothing:

- **1.** Cannot show profanity, obscenity, violence or symbols of hate.
- 2. Cannot promote alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
- **3.** Cannot promote gang colors or gang-related signs.
- 4. Cannot show underwear
- 5. Cannot show bare skin between upper chest/mid-thigh
- 6. Cannot wear tank topics, midriffs, pajama bottoms
- 7. Cannot have jeans with rips in them

Students out of compliance with the above will be provided a uniform or have their families asked to bring them other clothing that is appropriate. Additionally, students may be removed from class if out of compliance with AACPS dress code according to the student handbook. Thank you.


