Letter from Mr. Noon, Principal

January 24, 2022

Dear Families.

On Tuesday, January 25th we will be conducting a simulated lockdown emergency response drill. The lockdown will be in response to an unauthorized intruder in the building. There will be no weapons or simulated weapons as part of the drill. The drill will be initiated during a less structured time when students will be moving throughout the building. The Code of Maryland Regulations and the Maryland State Department of Education require every local school system to develop emergency plans and an annual drill schedule that addresses specific emergency responses. Students will be informed of the drill on Monday, January 24th and provided instruction on how to respond once the drill is initiated.

As we approach the midpoint of the school year, if you have not done so already I would encourage you to go to the Parent Portal (https://www.aacps.org/Page/1325) to check your child's current grades and progress. Students have a daily opportunity to meet with their teachers during Marlin Block where they can get help on an assignment or complete a redo. Please have a conversation with your child to maximize this opportunity.

I encourage all families to look through the <u>Updated Extracurricular Brochure</u> This is a great opportunity for students to try something new or participate in an activity of choice. Activity buses will be leaving the school at approximately 4:50 on Tuesdays and Thursdays. You can find the activity bus route list at https://busstops.aacps.org/Details.aspx?school=2243.

The Maryland State Department of Education requires each student to engage in 75 hours of service-learning prior to graduation. Each year all students in grades 6-8 are required to complete 10 hours of service learning that goes towards that requirement. This year all MRMS students will be learning about the purpose of our school's partnership with *Planet Aid* https://www.planetaid.org/about/mission).

Planet Aid is an organization that collects used clothing to help fund sustainable development projects in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. Presently, we have two large yellow bins in our parking lot for collecting donations. We will be encouraging participation during the next several weeks as students learn about the mission of Planet Aid. Additionally, we hope this experience will help students to be more environmentally aware and inspire them to make a difference in the world.

Early Dismissal / Return to School

I need to get my child out of school early for a dental/doctor appointment, what is the school policy for signing out a student?

- Your child will bring a note to the office when they enter the school that has the time they need to be dismissed. The phone number of the parent should be included.
- The office staff will issue a pass for the student to leave class at the requested time.
- At the time of early dismissal, the student should show the pass to his or her teacher, go to his or her locker, and report to the office to be signed out.
- If the student returns to school before the regular dismissal time, he or she should report to the office to get a pass before returning to class.

Adults <u>must</u> present identification in the form of a State-Issued Driver's License to school staff when signing out students. In order to sign a student out, the adult must be on the student's emergency card.

Absent Students

Parents and Guardians, please use the link below for each day your student was absent. Absences shall be treated as unlawful until the attendance office receives a written or electronic note justifying the absence. Additional documentation is not required unless requested by the school.

If your student has missed five or more consecutive dates, a doctor's note will be required.
