



6th Grade AVID students toured Anne Arundel Community College this week.

Last week approximately 250 8th graders were out in the schoolyard planting native grasses, shrubs and trees to help restore our school yard, prevent erosion, increase animal habitat, and of course, improve the look of our little section of Peninsula Farm Road. The student did a fabulous job, and as you can see from the pictures, the students enjoyed themselves. We also built some bluebird boxes that will be place around our school yard and Sever River Middle School. We planted the native plants in order to bring in more wildlife and provide them with the food sources and habitat they prefer. Magothy River Middle School is recognized as a Maryland Green School, and we will continue to do projects like this in the future.































Dear parents,

When you are waiting for your children in the parking lot, you tend to leave your car on until they arrive. By leaving your car running for even 5 seconds, you end up exposing us and your students to CO2 from car emissions. Car emissions contain CO2, toxins and harmful chemicals that can affect our lungs -even to the point where kids can receive cancer by breathing in all the car emissions. Think about it this way: if in every school, parents are keeping their cars on while waiting for their children, that will add up to a lot of kids getting exposed to those gases. If they are being picked up every day, imagine how much CO2 and chemicals are now in their lungs. Those children would be harmed, even if they didn't notice.


Car idling doesn't only end up affecting the students, but also the environment by the emissions that your car produces. The car emissions, which contain CO2 and other gasses, contribute to the greenhouse effect. The greenhouse effect is what is warming the earth's surface when the atmosphere traps these gases, eventually causing global climate change which is impacting us now.

There are simple solutions to stop car idling, such as parking your car while you wait. If you are waiting for more than 10 seconds, it's best to park. This would be good for the environment and for you since, by doing that you are saving gas and money. There are also many other solutions including letting your child walk or bike to school if they live close enough. These solutions would be better for all of us, especially the students at Magothy and the environment.


