Dear Families,

Below is a link to AACPS press release from this morning that outlines the shift in safety protocols and guidelines for in-person learning. Additionally, I want to provide some clarification and the process we will be using for welcoming more students back into the building for in-person learning. **If you completed the survey requesting 4 days a week of in-person learning you will receive a separate communication informing you of your child's start date no later than Tuesday, May 25th.** Students should not arrive at the school, outside of their already assigned days, unless they have received the communication confirming they have been added to that cohort.

We will be bringing students back by grade level as soon as we are able to process the requests.

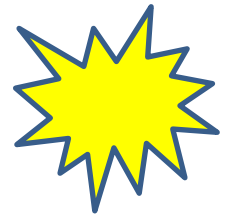

**Clothing:** Cannot show profanity, obscenity, violence, or symbols of hate.  
Cannot promote alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.  
Cannot promote gang colors or gang-related signs.  
Cannot show underwear.  
Cannot show bare skin between upper chest and mid-thigh.

*Examples of inappropriate dress:*

- baseball caps, hoods
- tobacco or alcohol brand shirts
- pajama bottoms / slippers
- clothing that reveals underwear
- clothing that shows bare skin between upper chest and mid-thigh

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*You cannot wear clothes that create a disruptive environment or cause a health or safety hazard.*

*\*\*Students who violate the dress code will be asked to change clothes.*

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# 2021 Secondary Summer School Information

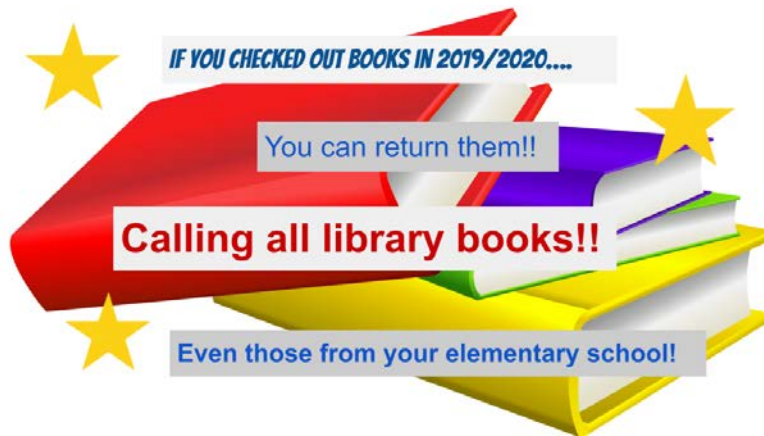
July 7 through August 10, 2021

The secondary summer school program offers students a limited number of secondary school courses and provides students the opportunity to:

- make up work in which they were unsuccessful.
- improve grade averages in sequential subjects.
- earn credits to meet high school graduation requirements.

Each course is highly concentrated and reviews the course content. Courses meet for two hours and 45 minutes each day. All courses will have two-hour final exams on the last day of summer school. There must be a minimum of 12 students enrolled in a course for it to be offered.

## **NEWS FROM THE HEALTH ROOM**

Parents, please continue to screen your child daily for symptoms of illness **before** they leave for school. If your child reports or exhibits any symptom, please do not send them on the bus or to the school building.

- Per current policy, any student who reports or exhibits one single symptom of illness will be sent home immediately from the school building.
- Any student who reports or exhibits any 2 symptoms of illness will be sent home immediately **and** required to obtain Covid testing. Documentation of a negative PCR test is required before the student may return to in-person class attendance.
- Please continue to report any positive Covid diagnosis of your student or in your household to the Health Room or Administration. This information is important to maintain safety in our Hybrid cohorts.

**Parents of 6th grade students**, please schedule a medical appointment now to obtain additional immunizations (tetanus/pertussis booster and meningococcal vaccine) required before entry to 7th grade. (Your child may have already received these doses, so please verify first with their health care provider). Please send documentation of your child's updated immunization record to the Health Room as soon as possible.

## **Important Information for 6th Grade Parents**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As you may know, there is a new state requirement regarding the documentation of two additional immunizations for all students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade each year. Before your student can enter 7<sup>th</sup> grade next year, you must provide written proof that he/she has received a **Tdap** (tetanus/ pertussis booster) and a **Meningococcal** (MCV4) vaccine.

- These immunizations are not "new", but the documentation requirement for school entry is new.
- These immunizations are typically given at the 11 year old well-child evaluation. If your child has already had an 11 year old well-child appointment, these immunizations may have already been given.
- If your child has not had a well check-up, contact your health care provider as soon as possible to set up an appointment for these immunizations

**Please contact your pediatrician to request a copy of your child's immunization record.**

All Hybrid Learners receive a free breakfast and free lunch delivered to their classroom. This is a great opportunity for your child to try new foods while chatting with friends. Although your child may pack a lunch, there is no need for you to do so. There is also no paperwork needed to see if you qualify for free meals. During the pandemic, free meals are offered to all children, ages 2 – 18, in Anne Arundel County. Dinner and a snack are also provided free to all hybrid learners and will be delivered to the classroom prior to dismissal. Dinner and snack can be enjoyed at home.
