I would encourage you to have your child available to assist you in navigating their Google Classroom. This week teachers have been reviewing the Student Code of Conduct during Building Community. 

BE ON TIME

Allow yourself plenty of time to wake up & get ready



Make sure your tech is charged

Be prepared before starting

PRESENTATION

Can we see you? Is your camera on?
Can we hear you?
Is your microphone on?

Are you in an open, quiet space in your home?



MUTE YOURSELF

If someone is talking - mute your microphone

(Muting helps cut down on extra noise!)

HEADPHONES



Use headphones if you have them

(Cuts`down on background noise, easier to hear you, and less disruptive to others in your home)

CHAT RESPONSIBLY



? = means I have a question

! = means I have something to share

Be focused- make

eye contact

NEW REGISTRATIONS

Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

During the COVID-19 State-mandated shutdown, Anne Arundel County Public Schools is using a remote process to enroll students for the 2020-2021 school year for grades K-12.

The following documents are required for enrollment:

- ·Child's documents –
- o Birth Certificate
- o Immunization Record
- o Recent Report Card or Transcript
- · Parent's documents –
- oGovernment-issued photo ID
- o Primary proof of residency: mortgage, deed, or lease
- oSecondary proof of residency: utility bill, bank statement, or paystub in the last 60 days
- o Custody Order (if applicable)

Hint: Be sure to have your documents saved and ready, in PDF or JPEG format, before you enter the portal because the system cannot accept incomplete registrations and you'll have to re-enter all data fields.


