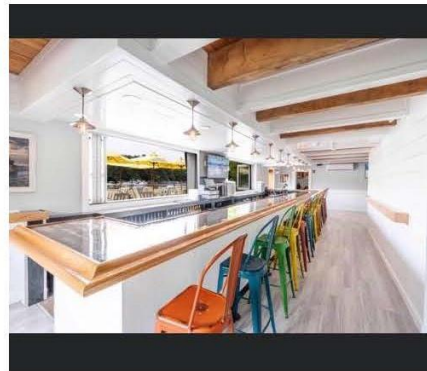
NJHS News:
