What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom as a classroom on the web.


Teachers use Classroom to share assignments, resources, hold class discussions, and provide feedback to students.



Getting Started


AACPS students should log into the Chrome Browser using their studentID#@aacps.org and their current password. Watch this tutorial on how to log in.


Accessing Google Classroom

From the Classlink page, select Google Classroom.




Please note that the Classroom link may be in a different location on your child's Classlink page.



The Student Classwork Tab

The Classwork tab is where students can access their assignments.

What do the icons on the Classwork page mean?






This is a discussion question. The students must answer a question in Classroom.



If an icon is gray, that means the assignment or question has been completed and turned in!


Navigating an Assignment
