Message from the Principal...

Good day Parents and Guardians! We are headed into week two of the state mandated two-week break. I hope all of you are staying healthy during this time. This has been quite the adjustment for me and my family. I can imagine it is an adjustment for all of us. Please let your student know I miss them all so very much! Much of the information I will share today is the same from last week. However, all of it is still important.

Anne Arundel County Public Schools understand the importance of keeping all students healthy and learning during this break. Please remind your student that they have access to ClassLink (from any device connected to the internet). All instructional applications and online materials will remain available. Additionally, for families who do not have access to internet and electronic devices, learning packets will be distributed at the school-based meals sites.

Additional meal sites have been added, with a total of 60 total sites. Children can go to any of the 37 school sites from noon to 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday or the 23 additional mobile meals at the specified times. Children do not have to be eligible for free and reduced-price meals to pick up meals. Adults cannot accept meals on behalf of children who are not present. Anne Arundel County Public Schools is working closely with the Anne Arundel County Department of Health (AACDOH) with regard to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The AACDOH is, in turn, collaborating with the Maryland Department of Health and receiving guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
