



MEADE MIDDLE SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY 2020-2021



Please help us stress the importance of following the Uniform policy by making sure that your child is coming to school dressed appropriately every day! Meade Middle, an academic institution, believes uniforms can improve learning by reducing distractions, sharpening focus on schoolwork and making the classroom a more serious environment, allowing our scholars to perform better academically.

Tops:

6th Grade: Black long or short-sleeved polo (collared) shirt with two or three buttons at the neck.

7th Grade: Navy blue long or short-sleeved polo (collared) shirt with two or three buttons at the neck.

8th Grade: Gray long or short-sleeved polo (collared) shirt with two or three buttons at the neck.

Pants:

Must be khaki-style pants in navy blue or a khaki color and must fit securely around the waist.

Jeans, leggings and sweatpants are not permitted.

Skirts/Shorts/Skortts:

Must be navy blue or khaki colored. The bottom of the garment must be no more than 3 inches from the center of the knee cap.

Additional Clothing:

Solid navy blue, gray, or black V-neck sweaters, front button cardigans, sweatshirts, hoodies (the hood may not be worn on your head while in the building) or fleece jackets, and Meade Middle School sweatshirts may be worn over uniforms during the school day.

College sweatshirts clearly stating the name of the college/university. Students may wear Meade Middle School Spirit Wear, Club and M-Power shirts with the appropriate uniform bottoms on Fridays.

Each student's polo collar should be visible when wearing a sweater, cardigan, sweatshirt, or hoodie (the hood may not be worn on your head while in the building).

Coats, jackets, jean jackets, and hats must be kept in lockers. In addition, bookbags and string bags must be kept in student's lockers. Plastic grocery bags may be used to carry PE uniforms.

Purses should be 5 x 7 in size or smaller. All fanny packs should be worn around the waist.

Consequences for not following the Uniform Policy:

Students that do not follow the policy will be addressed in homeroom. Students who are not in a school appropriate uniform may spend the day in an alternative educational setting.

- 1st Offense- Verbal Reminder to student
- 2nd Offense- Phone call home
- 3rd Offense- Lunch Detention
- 4th Offense- After-School Detention
- 5th Offense- Administration Consequence
