I hope all of you are continuing to access Parent Connect and reviewing your child's progress with them. The end of the marking period, November 7th, is right around the corner.

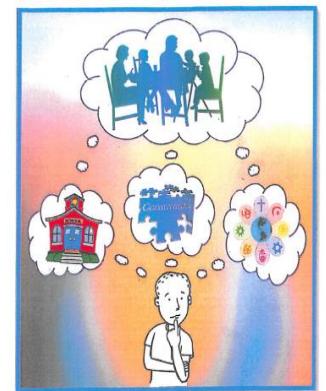
