New Gradebook Categories and Percentages

The MYP assessment model is also described as **criterion-related**, as it is based upon pre-determined criteria and objectives for each subject group. Students are assessed on each criterion throughout the marking period. Teacher gradebooks at Annapolis Middle School are designed to show student progress in each criterion.

In order to better align each subject group, the International Baccalaureate Organization has recently made some changes to the MYP criteria. Each subject area now has **four criteria**. Below are the criteria and weighted percentages for each subject group.
