## Uniform Support



<u>Uniform Assistance</u> Annapolis Elementary plans to maintain a School Uniform Closet where students may borrow needed items.

### **Recommended Quantities**

- 3-5 White, Navy Polo Shirts, or Button Down Oxford (short or long sleeved)
- 3-5 Khaki or Navy Pants
- 3-5 Khaki or Navy Shorts
- 3-5 Khaki or Navy Skirts/Skorts or Jumpers
- 1, White, Navy Crew-Neck Sweatshirt (No Hoods)
- 1 White, Navy Cardigan Sweater (Button Front)
- Several Pairs— ONLY Solid Black, Navy, or White Socks and/or Tights/Leggings (no prints or patterns) under skirts or jumpers
- 1 Pair of shoes—no lights, no wheels or no flip-flops
- Belts are optional but if worn should be Brown, Black or Navy

# **Uniform Program**

The Annapolis Elementary School Uniform Program was created to make learning the number one job for our students. Parents/Guardians and students are responsible for following the guidelines of the school uniform policy. (AACPS Policy 902.04A)

- 1. All students are required to wear the basic uniform which includes:
- Khaki or Navy pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers or skorts (no denim or Cargo style shorts or pants )
- White, Navy, polo or button down shirt (short or long sleeve), long sleeve turtle neck (no designs). Shirts must be tucked in.
- 2. In addition to our basic uniform, the following may be included:
- Solid navy, white crew neck sweatshirt or sweater
- Solid navy, white cardigan sweater
- Annapolis Elementary Spirit wear and Kelly Green polo shirts may be worn on <u>Fridays only</u> \*\*\*

3. Clothing **not** considered part of Uniform:

- Printed socks/tights/leggings
- Hooded or logo sweatshirts
- Sweatpants, jeans or Cargo pants/ shorts
- T-shirts (Except Annapolis Elementary Spirit wear on Fridays)

# **Uniform Program**

- \* Uniforms must be appropriate size with no logo
- \* Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- \* Uniforms must be clean and mended if torn (no holes)
- \* Black, brown or Navy belts are recommended if worn
- \* Skirt/shorts length must meet the AACPS dress code policy
- All uniform exception days will be announced (Picture Days, Spirit Days, Field Day, etc.)

#### Uniform Violations

Parents/Guardians will be contacted if a student is out of uniform. Violations of the school uniform policy will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the AACPS Code of student Code of Conduct.
