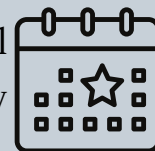

In an effort to be mindful about wellness, we have Fitness Thursday the first Thursday of each month. We do something fun with the students (ask them about it) and wear our fitness clothes. SACC AT BODKIN

With school hours now 8:00am-2:25pm, we wanted to let parents know about the School Aged Childcare (SACC) that is run by Anne Arundel County Recreation & Parks that is available at Bodkin (limited spots). The AM program operates from 7:00am until the start of the school day, and the PM program operates from the end of the school day until 6:00pm every day that school is open for students. An AM and PM snack are included in your monthly fee. Children must be at least 5 years old (not available for PreK students) by the first day of school to attend the elementary school programs. Being fingerprinted is required if you will be working one on one with students or for specific field trips (Arlington Echo or Drownproofing), but this does not expire. Please make sure your background check is up to date before volunteering. 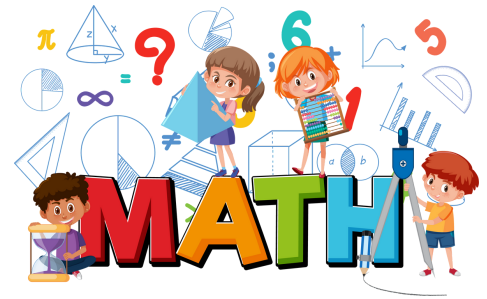

I-READY CHALLENGE

We have been challenged by our neighbors on the peninsula! Lake Shore Elementary has challenged Bodkin Elementary in amount of time we spend on our i-Ready program. In the latest report, both schools had 85% of students who only spent 0-9 minutes weekly on the i-Ready program. **The goal is to have each student spend at least 30 minutes weekly on both i-Ready Reading and i-Ready Math.** We need your help in winning this challenge! Students will be able to spend some time on i-Ready during the school day. However, they may not reach the 30 minutes that is expected in a week. Why is it important to get students on i-Ready? Students take a diagnostic assessment on the i-Ready program at least twice a year in both math and reading. It is shown that children who spend more time on i-Ready lessons often do better on the diagnostic. The i-Ready program challenges students on skill specific problems geared toward each student. The data on the Diagnostic assessment is used as an indicator for Gifted and Talented. It gives students practice on a device. Mostly all assessments are now given on a device electronically. At the end of February, we will compare schools to see who has the biggest increase in minutes! We hope Bodkin students do at least 30 minutes of i-ready in reading and math every week so Mrs. Myers can pie Lake Shore's principal, Mr. McCalpin! Let's have some fun, increase our learning, and beat Lake Shore!

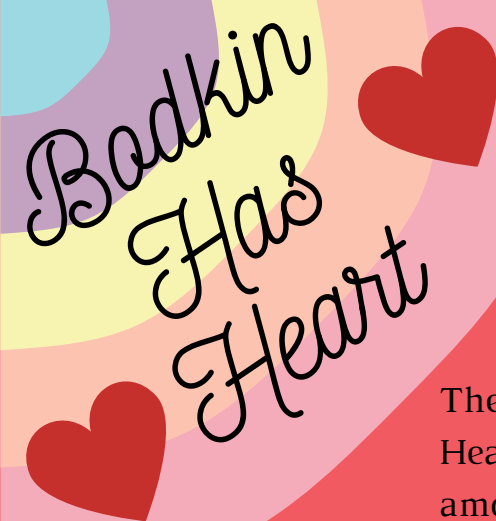

FROM THE HEALTH ROOM

AACPS requires that a physical examination be submitted to the school within the first 6 months of the school year for new students. We are quickly approaching that mark and reminder letters are being sent out. You may receive a letter stating that your student's file is missing a physical examination or a blood lead testing form. The most recent review of files was January 24th and any file missing those documents will receive a notification. This does not mean that your student will be excluded from school, but please provide the documentation as soon as possible.

- Physical Examination

-A well visit to your student's pediatrician will be accepted as long as it is dated within the past year

-Any notes from a physician's office should closely mirror the AACPS form. A copy of this form can be accessed [here](#)

- Blood Lead Testing

-Any student in Pre-K, Kindergarten, or 1st grade is required to have blood lead testing. This does not have to be a recent test - a test from any point in their life will be accepted. If you have any questions or concerns upon receiving the notification, please contact the school nurse at nurse2082@aacps.org.

OFFICE NEWS

OUT-OF-AREA TRANSFERS

Out-of-Area requests should be submitted to Mrs. Myers **between March 1 and May 1**. After May 1, they must be sent directly to Central Office with a valid reason for being late. An out-of-area transfer is a request for a student residing in Anne Arundel County to attend a school within the county other than the assigned boundary school (often referred to as a student's home school). If a child already attends Bodkin as an out-of-area approved student, the application must be completed and submitted each school year. The continuation of a previous year's out-of-area is not automatic, and the application must be submitted to the school during the out-of-area application window. 


KINDERGARTEN & PRE-K FOUR

Green School

Bodkin Elementary, in partnership with Atlantic Marinas, will be making boat shrinkwrap recycling available to boat owners in our community. This service is made possible by Marine Trades Association of Maryland, who is once again partnering with the Maryland Clean Marina Program and Chesapeake Materials. The cost for each recycling bag is just \$15. Each bag will hold up to 40 pounds of clean shrinkwrap (about a 34 ft. boat). Critical to the successful recycling of boat shrinkwrap is keeping it pure and clean. All straps, zippers, doors and vents must be removed for the wrap to be accepted. Because this service is only available to marinas, Atlantic Marina cannot accept bags from individual boat owners. Volunteers from Bodkin Elementary will schedule dates and times for pick up of empty bags and drop off of full recycling bags (dates/times TBD). All bags will then be transported to the marina for recycling. Please join us this year in being part of the solution to our plastic pollution. To sign up for a recycling bag click [here](#). 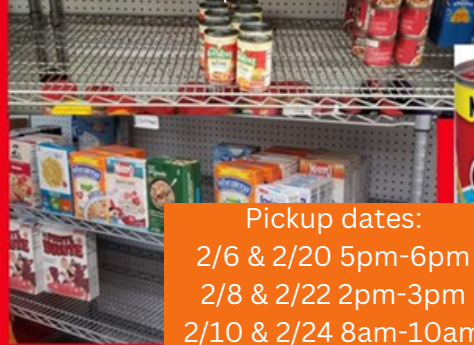
