

The President's Award for Educational Excellence



Dear Parents of Fifth Graders,

In cooperation with the United States Department of Education, Bodkin Elementary School will award the President's Award for Educational Excellence at the Fifth Grade Promotion Ceremony to fifth graders who meet the rigorous standards mentioned below. Listed below are the criteria that will be used to determine eligibility for the President's Award for Educational Excellence.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE Students must earn a grade point average of 90 or greater on a 100-point scale (an A on a letter scale or 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale). When computing grade averages, only the grade 4 school year and the first semester of grade 5 averages will be used.

STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES Students must have scored in the advanced range in both Reading AND Math in the Grade 4 Quarterly Assessments, 4th Grade MCAP scores and the Grade 5 Winter iReady Assessments.

OUTSTANDING CITIZENSHIP Students must demonstrate behaviors that reflect outstanding character and behavior during virtual and hybrid learning. When being considered for the award, the "Expected Student Behaviors" section of the report card will be taken into consideration. Only students with CD or PR will be eligible for the award. Outstanding Citizenship also addresses involvement in community service, extracurricular activities, or demonstration of achievement in creativity.

The final selection of students who are to receive this award will not be made until June. Children who earn this award will receive certificates signed by the President of the United States, the Secretary of Education, and the school principal. SACC AT BODKIN

With school hours now 8:00am-2:25pm, we wanted to let parents know about the School Aged Childcare (SACC) that is run by Recreation in Parks that is available at Bodkin (limited spots). The AM program will operate from 6:30am until the start of the school day, and the PM program will operate from the end of the school day until 6:00pm every day that school is open for students. An AM and PM snack are included in your monthly fee. Children must be at least 5 years old (not available for PreK students) by the first day of school to attend the elementary school programs. KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR 2023–2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Registration is for incoming kindergarten students who will be five years old by September 1, 2023. The Registration Portal opened for Kindergarten in April online here: https://www.aacps.org/Enrollment. Required documents for registration are, birth certificate, immunization records, and two proofs of residency. Register right away! Please call Bodkin with questions or if you need assistance. Please encourage your neighbors and friends with 5 year olds to register as soon as possible. Current Pre-K Four students at Bodkin will need to register for Kindergarten.

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FULL DAY FOUR-YEAR-OLD PRE-K

Parents who wish to apply for their child to attend Anne Arundel County Public Schools' prekindergarten program in the 2023-2024 school year may do so online beginning at **noon on Tuesday**, **May 2**, **2022**. AACPS offers prekindergarten programs for 4-year-olds in 58 schools and programs for 3-year-olds in eight schools.

For the first time this year and as called for by the Blueprint for Maryland's future, families will apply for prekindergarten through a centralized online enrollment process that is managed by the Early Childhood Office. Prekindergarten registration is no longer first come, first served. Applications are processed based on priority groups: income eligibility, students with disabilities, students from homes in which English is not the primary spoken language, and students who are homeless.

Information about prekindergarten programs in AACPS and an online application can be found at www.aacps.org/earlychildhood beginning at **noon on May 2**, **2023**.

Public prekindergarten programs in Maryland are designed to improve the school readiness of children who are income eligible for prekindergarten, homeless, have an active IEP, or speak a home language other than English. If seats remain, schools may enroll students with other readiness needs near the end of September. When offered a seat in the program, families applying for prekindergarten must provide:

- the student's original birth certificate or birth record.
- a copy of the student's immunization record.
- two proofs of residency (rental or mortgage agreement and current utility bill).
- custody order (if applicable).

Additionally, families must verify their income eligibility when offered a seat by submitting one of the following:

- Federal Income Tax Return (1040 statement), W2 or a C/1099 along with documentation related to other sources of income such as child support and/or rental income for each adult in the household
- Notarized letter of no income for each adult in the household
- Notarized Employment Letter for each adult in the household
- Military Income for each adult in the household
- Current award letter for Temporary Cash Assistance
- Current award letter for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- Medicaid documentation
- · Documentation from participation is Head Start/Early Head Start/ Even Start
- Documentation for foster care or ward of the state

Each elementary school in AACPS now has an assigned 4-year-old prekindergarten location. Families may only apply to their assigned prekindergarten location.

Anyone needing assistance in locating their assigned school, click on the Locate Your School link in the Schools section on the AACPS website, www.aacps.org, or contact the AACPS Planning Office at 410-439-5683 or planningoffice@aacps.org.

Families who do not have internet access or who need additional assistance completing an application should contact the school at which they intend to enroll their student. School staff are able to assist families with completion of the online
