

DISMISSAL

"My kid went where with whom?!" So that we NEVER have that scenario, we ALWAYS need a signed note from the parent/guardian when someone else is to pick up a student. Listing someone on an emergency card **does not** give them free access to pick up your student whenever. Without a note, we have no idea if you are aware of this early dismissal. So what IS the purpose of additional names on an emergency card?! Here is the inside scoop! The ONLY purpose for listing additional names on the emergency cards is if your student is sick or school closes unexpectedly (ie, loss of power/water, etc) and we are UNABLE to get in touch with you, who may we contact to pick up your student? It's that simple. With a note, we know that you know!

PARENTS AND VOLUNTEERS

Social media can be a convenient, fun, and rewarding way to share your life and opinions with family and friends. However, using social media involves certain risks and responsibilities. These guidelines apply to all forms of social media:

Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), parents have the right to prevent photographs of their children from being taken in instructional settings. Given that volunteers have no knowledge of which parents have allowed their children to be photographed and which have not, volunteers may not take or post online any photographs or videos of students. This includes all school-sponsored events. Thank you for your cooperation with this most important issue of safety for our students.

STUDENT SUPERVISION

Unless children are practicing for chorus or some other teacher-supervised activity, students will not be allowed to enter the building before the first bell rings at 7:40am. Do not drop and go prior to 7:40am.

When children return to our building for evening activities with their parents, good school behavior is expected. Parents are requested to supervise their children during these times. No one should be in any classroom without permission and supervision.

EXTREME WEATHER CAR RIDER PROCESS

In the event of extreme weather during car rider dismissal time, the following procedures will be put into place:

- ·A Connect Ed Phone Call/Email/Text message will be sent to our entire community at all available email addresses and phone numbers notifying you of the implementation of the procedure below.
- ·Car Riders will be delayed until the last bus dismisses (approx. 2:40pm)
- ·The car rider line will form at CBMS as usual so that it does not block the buses from accessing the school.
- ·When the last bus has been loaded, the first car will drive down to Bodkin and enter through the bus loop.
- ·Students will remain under cover and will be dismissed to their car.
- ** All parents are encouraged to monitor the weather before school and to be prepared for these changes as car rider dismissal will be significantly delayed in order to keep students and staff safe.
- *** This process will be used VERY rarely. For normal weather conditions, the car rider line will remain the same—behind Bodkin at CBMS. Please plan ahead and send your child in with a rain coat/poncho, rain boots and/or an umbrella.



CANDY WRAPPER RECYCLING

Bodkin is excited to announce that we are participating in Rubicon's Trick or Trash™ program! Rubicon's mission is to end waste and in 2019 with this goal in mind, they shared their passion for sustainability with the candy wrapper collection program. Did you know that 600 million pounds of candy are purchased for Halloween and the wrappers can NOT be recycled through AA Co curbside recycling and if they don't end up in the landfill, they are often found littering our communities this time of year.

As part of Bodkin's green initiatives, we're encouraging families to save ALL plastic, aluminum and paper candy wrappers to send into school to be placed in the Trick or Trash™ box in the lobby. Once full, the PTA will send the box back where it will be processed through a recycling facility that turns the plastic wrappers into pet waste bags and the paper and aluminum will be recycled properly. 




