VOLUNTEERING

To be eligible to go on a field trip, volunteer for a club, to help in a classroom, to make copies, or for an event, you must have a current background check through AACPS. Background checks expire every 2 years. Being fingerprinted is required if you will be working one on one with students or for specific field trips (Arlington Echo or Drownproofing), but it does not expire. Please make sure your background check is up to date before volunteering. To find out the status of your background check, email Mrs. Burns in the office at jmburns1@aacps.org or call the school office. To complete a background check, click on Apply for Background Check at the bottom of this link.

TRANSPORTATION

Please help us ensure that your child's arrival and dismissal are smooth each day. Your adherence to the following is greatly appreciated:

- 1. Keep the car rider line moving. It is only intended for students who are prepared to exit and say goodbye quickly. Morning drop off is at the flag pole in front of Bodkin (park if you will need longer to disembark). Afternoon pick up is in the lower lot of Chesapeake Bay Middle School. Students must not be dropped off prior to **7:40 am**.
- 2. Keep the transportation plan consistent. Children thrive on routine and struggle to remember changes. While we understand that last minute changes are necessary from time to time, please try to adhere to a consistent transportation plan. For last minute changes, make sure to send a signed note in with your child in the morning. In order to authorize a change, we must have your signature. Requests made via email or phone will require a fax or note dropped off at school before we will notify your child of a change of transportation procedure.
- 3. Behavior expectations are the same on the bus as in school. All of the same rules apply while riding on the bus! Remember, it's a privilege to ride the bus!

NO PARKING IN FIRE LANE AT ANY TIME

Parking in designated fire lanes and/or bus loops is prohibited. This prohibition extends to staff, students, visitors, spectators at athletic events, day care vans, and after school activity vans such as karate centers, clubs, etc. Any vehicle parked in a fire lane or obstructing a fire hydrant must be moved to an authorized parking space.

Maryland Motor Vehicle Law §21-101.1(b)2,3 states,

A person may not drive a motor vehicle in violation of any provision of this title on any property that is owned by or under the control of this State or any of its political subdivisions, county boards of education, or community colleges and that is open to vehicular traffic and used by the public in general. Any person who violates any provision of this subsection is in violation of the law to the same extent and is subject to the same penalty as if the motor vehicle were driven on a highway.

As you know, in a critical emergency, the loss of every minute caused by vehicles blocking fire and police department access can become critical.

Please remember to send your child to school in appropriate footwear on PE days. Crocs are super popular now, but they are not tennis shoes. No boots or flipflops. Students need to wear sneakers/tennis shoes on their assigned PE day. Thanks so much for your support!

HEALTH ROOM TIPS

- If your student is sick, please keep them at home. Our students need to be able to focus on their academic studies and that is hard to do when they don't feel well.
- If a student has a fever of 100.0 degrees or over, they need to be kept home for 24-hours until fever-free without medications. We also recommend testing for COVID with any presentation of a fever, especially over 100.4 degrees.
- AACPS COVID procedures follow the recommendations from the CDC.
- o Symptoms to look out for: sore throat, cough, congestion, fever, and fatigue
- o If your student is positive or exposed, please reach out to the Health Room and we will provide you with the appropriate actions for your student's return to school.
- If your student has a medication they take regularly or as needed that should be kept at school, prescription or over the counter, here are some tips:
- o These can be brought to the Health Room on the first day of school with the appropriate documentation.
- o There is a form that must be filled out by the pediatrician before any medication can be brought to school. If you need a copy, please email nurse2082@aacps.org and we will send it to you.
- o All medications (whether prescription or over the counter) must be new, sealed, in the original packaging it came in, and (if applicable) with the prescription attached.
- o No medication is to be brought to school by a student. It must be brought by an adult with the proper medication administration form signed by a physician.

LUNCHES

If your student had money left over on a lunch account (from a previous year) and remains in an Anne Arundel County public school, the money remains on the account and will roll over to this year. This includes Fifth Graders going to middle school. If you would like to check a balance, or add money, it is FREE to set up an account on www.mypaymentsplus.com. Students in grades kindergarten, first and second grades will not be required to transport their Chromebook back and forth. A school Chromebook will be assigned to these students. Students in grades 3-5 will be required to bring their charged Chromebook to school each day. If you are new to our school, we will get them one on the first week of school.







SUPER TIPS & TRICKS FOR BACK TO SCHOOL

- Plan. Use a calendar and make a plan for the family to include sports, extracurricular, school events, birthday parties and homework/projects.
- Tighten up on screen/phone/tablet/gaming time. Regardless of your child's technology interests, having a healthy balance is, well, healthier.
- Schedule time to read together (tell them it's a Bodkin requirement).
- Sleep...take a look at bed times and sleep as students transition back to school especially with our new schedule. Elementary age children require 10-11 hours and some need a little more.
- Talk...check in. How is your child feeling about coming back? Schedule a playdate or time to meet friends at a park or other outing. Seeing friends/classmates before the first day can help your child feel more connected as they return.
- Create a cool study space. While collecting back to school supplies, create a home area reserved for homework/projects. Buy extra pencils, a sharpener, paper, markers, glue, and scissors for at home availability.
- Designate a drop spot for bookbags/instruments, etc. for easybreezy mornings.
- Practice using the evenings as a "get ready" time. Set out clothes, pack lunch, and scan the plan for the next day/evening activities. Evaluate how it is going. Let the kids have some say in the plan and it is likely to work out easier.
- Set up a file (or bin) for school papers. It can be a great drop spot for kiddos and serve as great reminders.
- Stay involved. Something is sent home with your child most days. Be sure your child(ren) use the planner, stay on top of Parent Portal, and check the take-home folder nightly. It can be helpful to network with classmates when there are questions.
- Connect with your child's teacher. If there is something you think would be helpful for your child's teacher to know as he/she gets to know your child...reach out. Send a quick email or call.
