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Health & Safety

It is important that families complete a daily symptom check and keep children home if they are ill. More information will be coming regarding the reporting procedures for positive Covid cases for students and family members.

Students and staff will be required to wear a mask for the entire day. They can remove their mask during breakfast and lunch. Students must remain socially distant from others.

Hand sanitizer stations are in the classroom and throughout the building. Students will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer and wash their hands.

Face Coverings

Per CDC guidelines, cloth face coverings should be worn at all times, by all persons in school facilities, with exceptions for certain persons who, because of a disability, cannot wear a mask or wear a mask safely, or for certain settings such as while eating or drinking.



Students will be expected to wear a cloth face covering except when eating meals. Face coverings must be worn at the bus stop and traveling on a bus to school.

- Face coverings must be worn over the nose and mouth and securely around the face.
- Choose face coverings with breathable material that fit snugly, but comfortably over the nose and mouth.
- Help your student understand that wearing a face covering may help prevent others from getting sick
- Show your student how to carefully place and remove their face covering with clean hands
- Neck gaiters and other similar products are not acceptable as cloth face coverings.

Be sure to label your student's face covering. Students should bring at least two additional face coverings to school, in the event that they need to change their face covering during the school day.

Chromebook Care

Hybrid and Virtual Learning has been a unique experience for all and some issues that occur may be prevented with proper care of the chrome book and others with some simple steps:

Proper care to prevent damage:

- Use Chromebook on a stable surface
- Keep food, drinks and other materials away from the area while using chromebook
- Have clean hands before and during the time you are using the chromebook
- Close lid when moving about and be careful not to pull or knock chromebook or pull cord
- Shut down when not in use and keep chromebook charged

Note: Each school has a limited number of replacement chromebooks available for

student use and at this time there is a waiting list Brock Bridge Elementary.

Kindergarten Registration for 2021-2022 School Year on Wednesday, April 7

Anne Arundel County Public Schools' kindergarten registration for the 2021-2022 school year begins on Wednesday, April 7, and parents and guardians can reserve their child's seat by enrolling online. Children enrolling in kindergarten must be 5 years old on or by September 1, 2021.

The following documents are required and will need to be uploaded when registering a child for kindergarten:

Proof of identity

* The child's original birth certificate or birth record

A copy of the child's immunization record

Two proofs of residency

* deed/lease/mortgage and current utility bill

La mejor opción para completar la inscripción de Kínder es mediante nuestro Portal de Inscripción en Línea. A través de este portal, el padre/tutor legal completará la documentación de inscripción y agregará la documentación requerida usando su computadora de escritorio, computadora portátil o teléfono inteligente, o considerará utilizar recursos de la comunidad con acceso a computadora/ Internet. Utilice el enlace que se muestra abajo en este comunicado.

Si las familias no pueden completar el proceso en línea, las siguientes opciones están disponibles:

Póngase en contacto con la escuela para que un miembro del personal complete la solicitud en línea a través del teléfono en su nombre y envíe una foto de los documentos a la Secretaria de Inscripción ya sea por correo electrónico o texto usando Google Voice, o programe una cita para la entrega de estos documentos.

Póngase en contacto con la escuela para programar una cita en persona; estos tendrán una disponibilidad limitada y probablemente podrían extenderse a los meses de verano.

Los padres o tutores legales deben estar seguros de tener cada uno de estos documentos listos para agregar antes de ingresar el Portal de inscripción en Línea guardándolos en formato PDF, JPG o PNG.

Los siguientes documentos son necesarios para cada inscripción; estos documentos deben agregarse en el portal en línea para que el sistema acepte el envío de inscripción:

- ✓....Comprobante de identidad de los padres: un ID o identificación con foto emitida por el gobierno local o estatal
- ✓....Comprobante principal de residencia: hipoteca, título de propiedad o arrendamiento
- ✓....Comprobante secundario de residencia de los últimos seis días: factura de servicios públicos (agua, luz, cable), estado de cuenta bancario, o talón de pago de su trabajo
- ✓....Certificado de nacimiento del estudiante
- ✓....Registro o cartilla de vacunación del estudiante
- ✓....Orden Legal de Custodia (si corresponde)
