Dear Parents/Guardians.

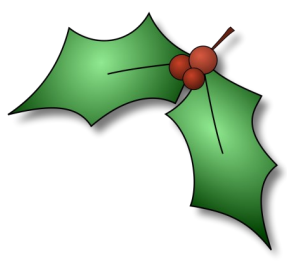
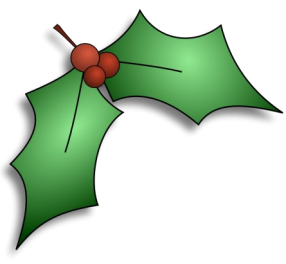
