While this was not our traditional school year, it is hard to believe that it is almost over. We have learned a lot over the last year and appreciate your support as we have navigated this process together.

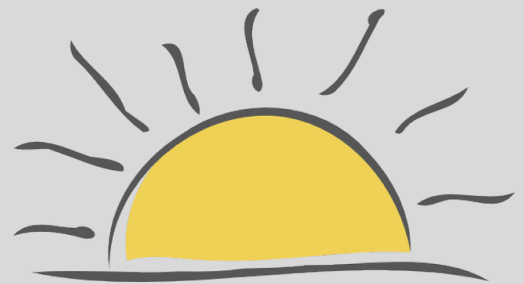

## Pre-K and Kindergarten Registration for the 2021-2022 School Year

Anne Arundel County Public Schools' kindergarten registration for the 2021-2022 school year is still open. Children enrolling in Pre-K must be 4 years old and Kindergarten must be 5 years old on or by **September 1, 2021**.

The following documents are required and will need to be uploaded when registering a child for kindergarten:

- 1) **Proof of identity**  
\* The child's original birth certificate or birth record
- 2) **A copy of the child's immunization record**
- 3) **Two proofs of residency**  
\* deed/lease/mortgage and current utility bill

## Transferring Students



If your student will be transferring over the Summer, please contact Ms. Mason by email at [tmason@aacps.org](mailto:tmason@aacps.org) with the new school information so that a transfer packet can be prepared.

If your student will be transferring out of Anne Arundel County, out of the State or to Monarch Global or Chesapeake Science Point, please know that your student must turn in their Chromebook to Brock Bridge Elementary by the end of June. Please see message below from The Board of Education.

AACPS Devices are provided to students enrolled in AACPS. Per the device agreement form, ***"At the conclusion of your participation in this program, your withdrawal or transfer from AACPS, or upon request by AACPS you must return this Chromebook and power adapter to the Principal/designee at your school."***

Failure to do so will result in an obligation **\$295.00.**

***Charter Schools are not owned or operated by AACPS and therefore use their own devices. Our AACPS enrolled Chromebooks will not have access to their Google portal and applications.***

If you have moved or are in the process of moving, please provide the school office with updated paperwork and address, so we can keep your student's information accurate in our system.



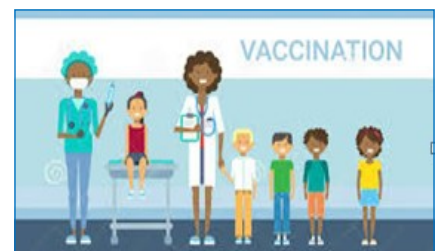
In the case your student is moving to another school, please let us know so we can get the transfer packet to be sent to the other school or for pick up.

## Immunization Requirements

All students starting Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten shall have 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccine and 2 doses of Varicella (VAR) vaccine.

Enrolling students must show proof of these immunizations with either an official certificate of immunization, a photocopy of or written documentation from their physician.

Brock Bridge Elementary School's Immunization Requirements are compatible with the current recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunizations Practices (ACIP) of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).



***Maryland Law allows (a) physicians to write medical exemption statements which clearly state a medical reason exists and the person cannot receive specific vaccines, and (b) parents/guardians to choose an exemption from immunization requirements for reasons of conscience, including a religious belief.***



## **BROCK BRIDGE ELEMENTARY SUMMER FUN N' PLAY PROGRAM**



We are so pleased to have the opportunity to open a Summer Fun N' Play program at **BROCK BRIDGE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL** during the month of July 2021!

**INFORMATION:** In this program we plan to provide the following:

- Arts and crafts, games, activity stations, and STEM & Literacy enrichments
- Outdoor play will be utilized as we are able depending upon weather, sharing space with the school, site layout and restrictions.
- Breakfast & Lunch will also be provided for FREE to the children via our partnership with Anne Arundel County Public Schools' Food and Nutrition Services.

**SUMMER SCHEDULE:** This specially funded summer program will be open as follows:

- Monday - Friday
- 8:00am - 3:00pm daily
- July 6, 2021 - July 30, 2021

**RESTRICTIONS:** This program will follow the most current COVID-19 restrictions for summer camp/child care programs at the time of opening. At this time, the restrictions are as follows:

Current COVID-19 restrictions include the following: children & staff members must wear masks (except when eating), heightened sanitizing & social distancing will be in place, and temperature checks & health screenings are required upon arrival of staff and children. Parents may not enter the child care space and must also wear masks at all times. We will follow the guidance of the Health Department to close/alert the program as necessary if a child/staff member meets the symptom/exposure criteria to do so.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

- There is a \$10.00 fee due at the time of registration.
- Otherwise, the program is **FREE** for participants!

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- **AGES:** Children must be **entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade** for the 2021-2022 school year to be eligible to attend.
- **STATE MANDATED FORMS:** Every child must have the State mandated forms completed and on file at the site on their first day.
- **TOILETING:** Children must be toilet trained. Your child must be able to be self-directed & self-sufficient in the restroom and able to care for their own hygiene needs.

### **INTERESTED IN REGISTERING FOR A SPACE?**

Please be aware that there is a minimum and a maximum registration for each Summer Fun N' Play program. We must receive at least 10 parents interested in the program **by June 11, 2021** in order to prepare to open in July. The maximum # we can care for will be dependent upon COVID restrictions for distancing and space available in the school. To register for a space:

3. Our Billing & Registration team will reach out to families to confirm the final decision & opening date by June 1<sup>st</sup>!
