Student Instruction:

During student instruction, in-person students may complete work on the Chromebook or using paper and pencil. Cultural Arts will remain virtual for students in the classroom.

It is important that families complete a daily symptom check and keep children home if they are ill. More information will be coming regarding the reporting procedures for positive Covid cases for students and family members.

Students and staff will be required to wear a mask for the entire day. They can remove their mask during breakfast and lunch. Students must remain socially distant from others.

Hand sanitizer stations are in the classroom and throughout the building. Students will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer and wash their hands.

Out of State/Country Travel:

The governor issued an emergency order requiring Marylanders to limit all travel to essential purposes only. All Marylanders who do travel outside of Maryland or any individuals who do travel to Maryland must either obtain a negative COVID-19 test result or self-quarantine for 10 days. This applies to all states, with the exception of Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and Washington, DC.

Supplies:

Students should bring the items from the backpack distribution (Composition books, math manipulatives, art supplies, sticky notes, personal sharpener, sharpened pencils, crayons, gluestick and markers). In addition, chromebooks should be fully charged with their charger and headphones. Students should bring a water bottle and books.

Breakfast / Lunch:

Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to classrooms for any student who wishes to have one. Students will be provided with dinner and snack at the end of the day.

Chromebooks:

All hybrid students have been offered a chromebook. If you have decided to use a personal device, a technology waiver must be signed.

Arrival

Students will be permitted to enter the building at 9:00AM.

- Family units should remain distanced from other family units.
- Walkers & 5th graders will enter through the front door. Bus riders and car riders will enter through the media door.
- Once those students have cleared, buses will be unloaded one at a time.
- Car riders will be permitted inside as they arrive. Arrival after 9:15AM comes through the front door.

Dismissal

- Dismissal begins at 3:40 PM.
- Walkers will be dismissed first.
- Parents picking up walkers need to stand at a socially distanced marker and wait there for their child. Please exit school property as quickly as possible.
- Once walkers have cleared, buses and car riders will be dismissed.
- Buses will be dismissed and loaded one at a time.
- Car rider families will receive a hang tag with their student's name and teacher on it. This is to be visible upon arrival at BBES. A staff member will walkie inside for the student(s) to come out.
- The parents will follow directions of staff around the car loop until they reach the stations. Parents will pull up to the next available cone and additional staff members will direct students to their cars.
- ***In accordance with health department guidelines, anyone over the age of 2 must be masked when on school grounds.***
- ***Parents should remain in their vehicles at all times.***

Late Arrivals (after 9:15 am)

- Student or Guardian will use the buzzer to contact the office
- Office staff will ask reason for lateness and let the student in the building
- Student will be entered into the system and sent to class with pass

Early Dismissals

No students will be dismissed after 3:00 pm

- Parents are asked to call ahead and notify office of early dismissal. If parent contacts teacher, please ask them to call the office.
- Parents will be instructed to bring ID and do not bring siblings. ID will be checked and parent will wait between the double doors in the main entrance.
- Student will be called down and exit through the main door to the parents waiting (Office will monitor)
