As we prepare for the upcoming school year, I am writing to provide you with information concerning our plans to further our use of departmentalized instruction in 4th grade. Simply stated, departmentalized instruction is a model that allows for teachers to specialize in a single subject matter and further their use of differentiation. For students, this model allows for student movement throughout the day and to be challenged by different teachers who have created classroom environments focused on their subject. Furthermore, working within this model will further prepare students for the organizational and instructional demands of the intermediate grades as well as middle school.

During the 2016-2017 school year, our 4th grade will have 4 classrooms. Mrs. Teal and Mrs. Simmons will focus on Language Arts instruction including reading and writing. Mrs. Rhoades will focus on Mathematics instruction as well as Social Studies and Mrs. McMahon will focus on Mathematics instruction as well as Science. The class that your student attends for the morning session will be considered their homeroom for the purpose of attendance, cultural arts, and field trips.

We have included a sample schedule of the student day for you to use as you discuss the upcoming school year with your student.
