# Crofton Meadows Elementary Weekly Wrap Up - Friday, January 24, 2020

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Good Afternoon Crofton Meadows Elementary Families!

Here is your Weekly Wrap Up for the week ending Friday, January 24, 2020.

**What's Happening** - Much of this week was dedicated to the students finishing up work for the second marking period. Students in grades 2 – 5 also completed quarterly math and reading assessments. The Kindergarten teachers are assessing the reading level of each of their students. This is a mid-year progress check on the students' reading ability. All students are beginning to set personal and academic goals for the second half of the school year.

Next week is the end of the second marking period which includes several days of different schedules. Tuesday and Wednesday, January 28 and 29, 2020, are 2-hour early dismissal days. We will dismiss at 12:55 PM on both days. Thursday, January 30, 2020 is a teacher workday and therefore no school for the students. This day is built into the school calendar to provide time for teachers to prepare report cards for the students. Report cards will be sent home on February 10, 2020.

**Second Step at CMES** - Each morning students will be learning skills to reinforce positive learning behaviors and social skills that are essential to their success as lifelong learners. Periodically, students will be bringing home follow up activities from the classroom lessons that can be done with a parent to reinforce these skills. The first set of skills that the students are taught is how to focus their attention and ignore distractions through self-talk. # **Reminders:**

<u>Appropriate dress for the weather</u>: Please remember to have students wear coats and other cold weather garments to school. If the "feels like" temperature is above 32 degrees, and the weather is nice, the students go outside for recess. Also, remember to label their clothing with the student's name so the item can be returned to the rightful owner, if lost.

<u>Absence notification</u>: Student absent notes must be in written or electronic (email) form. You can email the student's teacher directly. There is no need to call the office, as the teacher forwards these emails to the attendance secretary.

<u>Early dismissal</u>: If you are picking up your student for early dismissal, it is best to do so at least 15 minutes or more prior to the actual dismissal time (2:55PM). This will allow the student time to gather their belongings and come to the office. It will also help expedite your dismissal from the parking lot so you are not caught in the regular dismissal traffic.
