Here is your Weekly Wrap Up for the week ending Friday, January 31, 2020.

What's Happening - Today begins the third marking period for the 2019 – 2020 school year. This year is flying by! Students starting off fresh and are setting goals for the new marking period. We would like to thank all the families for the support they have giving their student and the school to help the children work toward and achieve their goals so far this school year.

Tomorrow starts the month of February! During February, the students will be participating in a Random Acts of Kindness Challenge. This initiative is an effort to celebrate and reinforce our school wide expectation of "Be Kind." Nightly, content area homework for the month of February has been canceled! In its place, we are asking each student to do two things. First, complete a random act of kindness. A Kindness Calendar is coming home with each student with suggestions for students to spread kindness. Please work with your child to encourage them to complete a kind act each day. At the end of the month please return the calendar signed. And second, we ask that the students read something of their choice for the same amount of time that their grade level requires. For example, if the grade level requires 20 minutes of reading each night, the students should continue to do that. We are encouraging students to make daily/nightly reading a habit, so we don't want to have a month-long break from reading. So to recap, the homework for the month of February will be a daily random act of kindness and self-selected reading. At the end of the month we will celebrate all the random acts of kindness the students, staff, and families have done to make our school and community a more peaceful and kind place in the world!

Reminders:

<u>Appropriate dress for the weather</u>: Please remember to have students wear coats and other cold weather garments to school. If the "feels like" temperature is above 32 degrees, and the weather is nice, the students go outside for recess. Also, remember to label their clothing with the student's name so the item can be returned to the rightful owner, if lost.

<u>Absence notification</u>: Student absent notes must be in written or electronic (email) form. You can email the student's teacher directly. There is no need to call the office, as the teacher forwards these emails to the attendance secretary.

<u>Early dismissal</u>: If you are picking up your student for early dismissal, it is best to do so at least 15 minutes or more prior to the actual dismissal time (2:55PM). This will allow the student time to gather their belongings and come to the office. It will also help expedite your dismissal from the parking lot so you are not caught in the regular dismissal traffic.
