Weekly Wrap Up – Each Friday, throughout the school year, we will publish a short email of weekly highlights at Crofton Meadows. Crofton Meadows Elementary has an Awesome Start to the 2019 – 2020 School Year – This week **547** students in grades Kindergarten through Fifth grade, started school at Crofton Meadows Elementary. It was awesome to see all the eager students excited to see their friends, meet their teachers and start learning. The parents of the kindergarten students met with their teachers and the students began their academic career with a staggered start. The first full day for <u>all</u> kindergarten students is Tuesday, September 10, 2019.

New Car Rider Dismissal Procedures - In an effort to ensure the safety of all students during our daily dismissal routine, the procedure for car rider dismissal has been changed. These changes were published on a green flyer and sent home with every student in the student's red folder. The procedures can also be found on the CMES website. In short, students no longer congregate on the median strip between the driveway and the parking lot. Adults that are picking up their student(s) on a regular basis are issued a "Pick Up" number. When that car arrives in the drop-off/pick-up line on the edge of the parking lot, their student will be called from the cafeteria to meet their ride. As the students, parents and staff get used to this new routine, the car rider pick up will become more efficient. Thank you for your patience as we implement and perfect this new routine to keep our students safe.

Band and Strings Assembly – Students in grades 3, 4 and 5 attended an assembly on Wednesday to hear about the Band and Strings programs at Crofton Meadows. Students interested in learning to play an instrument can sign up with parent permission. Flyers were sent home this week and are due back to Mr. Nicholas or Mr. Franck by Friday, September 13, 2019. Classes will start the week of September 16, 2019.

Back to School Night – On Wednesday, September 11, 2019, we will host our annual Back-to-School Night. The PTO will conduct a general membership meeting from 6:00 – 6:30 PM and the Back-to-School program will be from 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM. Parents will meet in the auditorium at 6:30 for a brief overview of the school program and then time will be allotted for classroom visits. Player of the Week and Team of the Week are also recognized!
