## The School Nurse and Nursing Assistant

- <u>all</u> medication administration
- aid in the treatment and prevention of illnesses and injuries
- perform nursing procedures (insulin injections, blood glucose monitoring, catheterization, tube feedings, etc.)
- immunization records up to date
- member of the school's crisis and educational team
- liaison to the community and community health care providers
- screenings for vision, and hearing.
- case management/education of chronic diseases (asthma, diabetes, etc.)
- ▶ locate health care and community resources for families; home visits



# Getting Ready!

## Preparing Your Child for Kindergarten

### Foster Independence

- time to skip naptime
- assign a simple chore
- develop a regular schedule at home
- read to your child daily
- make time for learning activities
- limit screen time



## Things to Practice

- tying shoes
- zipping jackets
- saying parents names, phone numbers and address
- using restroom facilities independently
- keeping track of personal belongings
- opening lunch containers/packets
- basic skills-full name, address, phone number, colors, shapes, using crayons, pencils, scissors and glue



### A Great Beginning...

The first couple weeks are an adjustment period. It's normal...

Tears are normal...

- most children will be very tired
- regular bedtime is extra important

"I don't want to go to school."


- this is also completely normal
- bring them to school anyway
- reassure them that everything will be just fine
- give them hugs and kisses and tell them you will see them after school, but once you drop them off, leave quickly
- focus on the positive "...one thing you liked today."

## The Nitty Gritty Details

- September: conferences and staggered entrance;
   Conferences September 8 & 9; Staggered entrance Sept 10, 13 & 14; First day all Kindergarten Sept 11
- Safety: As distanced as possible (not consistently 3 feet)
- Masks- no gaiters, extras in the back-pack
- ChromeBooks: K students leave them at home in a safe and secure place
- ▶ Illness: Cough, fever, sore throat, any cold-like symptom
- Quarantine: Positive Case: 10 days if within 3 feet for a cumulative 15 minutes
- Communication: Take Home Folders; Woody's World
- Free lunch and breakfast every day
- Snacks (please consider peanut free)
- Birthday celebrations (no food please)
- The "flow" of the school





## Arrival and Dismissal Routines




#### Arrival:

- walkers enter under the awning by the media center, safeties and adults are ready to help
- bus riders need to ride the bus (bus routes are on the website)
- car ride only when necessary
- drop off in the car rider lane only... the safeties will open car doors
- passenger side only for arrival and dismissal
- have your child <u>ready</u> to get out

#### Dismissal:

- "car riders" are only those whose parents are in the car rider line, please use the special sign (provided) on the visor of the passenger side
- Safeties will assist; we load 7-8 cars at a time so be patient
- bus riders are called out and monitored by a duty teacher
- walkers are dismissed only when the car rider lines and busses are clear





**CAR RIDERS** 

#### **REMINDERS:**

- Dismissal order: Car Riders, Open Door and Day Care Vans; Busses by number; Walkers
- All walkers exit through the doors by the Kindergarten playground
- There is <u>no</u> parking on Urby Drive; therefore, there should be NO student pick-up or drop-off on the street. This is a safety issue for students!
- . Pull all the way forward so we can unload and load as many students at once to help traffic move along.
- You will not be permitted to take a student from the car rider area unless you are physically in a car in queue.
- Students should be on the right side of the vehicle. Student safeties will assist students getting out of cars so you will not need to get out.
- Once you are ready to leave the car rider loop, please follow the traffic pattern. Passing other cars to use the by-pass lane is not recommended and backing up to change lanes is never recommended.
- Please get as many car signs as needed if you are having students picked up.




