





- 3:33 dismissal of bus riders
- as soon as the lot is clear (approx. 3:40) dismissal of walkers

#### Arrival and Dismissal Routines




#### Arrival:

- walkers enter under the awning by the media center
- bus riders need to ride the bus (bus routes are on the website)
- car ride only when necessary
- drop off in the car rider lane only... the safeties will open car doors
- passenger side only for arrival and dismissal
- safety patrols are ready to help
- have your child <u>ready</u> to get out

#### Dismissal:

- "car riders" are only those whose parents are in the car rider line parents should put the special sign (provided) on the visor of the passenger side
- Safeties will assist; we load 7-8 cars at a time so be patient
- bus riders are called out and monitored by a duty teacher
- walkers are dismissed only when the car rider lines and busses are clear



**CAR RIDERS** 

#### REMINDERS:

- Dismissal order: Car Riders, Open Door and Day Care Vans; Busses by number; Walkers
- All walkers exit through the doors by the Kindergarten playground
- There is <u>no</u> parking on Urby Drive; therefore, there should be NO student pick-up or drop-off on the street. This is a safety issue for students!
- Pull all the way forward so we can unload and load as many students at once to help traffic move along.
- You will not be permitted to take a student from the car rider area unless you are physically in a car in queue.
- Students should be on the right side of the vehicle. Student safeties will assist students getting out of cars so
  you will not need to get out.
- Once you are ready to leave the car rider loop, please follow the traffic pattern. Passing other cars to use the by-pass lane is not recommended and backing up to change lanes is never recommended.
- Please get as many car signs as needed if you are having students picked up.

#### Attendance

- Please do not send your child with a fever, cough, sore throat or any cold-like symptom as they will be identified as having a "Covid-like illness"!
- If a student tests positive, we will contact trace any student who has been within 3 feet for a cumulative 15 minutes. Those students may be quarantined for 10 days.
- The automated system, Connect-Ed, will notify you if your child is absent or late.
- Every absence must be accounted for with a note.
- Illness or death in the family is the only excused absence
- CWES does not provide work in advance of an absence
- 3 days or more out requires a doctor's note

## First Day Tidbits

- establish a consistent morning routines now (early to bed)
- take pictures early before school then get on the bus or drop off in the car rider line
- parents are encouraged to "kiss and go" whether you drop off in the car rider lane or walk your child to school, we've got this
- make sure your child has an appropriate mask and extra masks in the backpack
- no rolling backpacks (they don't fit in the lockers)
- ChromeBooks come back and forth in grades 3-5, K-2 keep them at home
- make sure your child knows how they are getting home, please be consistent-teachers AND the office must be made aware of changes BY 3:15



#### Communication

- check your child's backpack daily for papers and the agenda book
- colorful take-home folders will come home soon
- please send written notes of any changes to your child's routine (email <u>only</u> if 24 hours in advance)
- Problems? ... address concerns with the teacher first
- Email etiquette:
  - keep it short and sweet
  - allow for adequate response time
  - be positive, call if you have an immediate issue
- Social media/ phone etiquette:
  - take care about what you post (stay positive; take the high road)
  - NO PICS of other children, other than your own are permitted on Social Media or on your phone







#### STAY INFORMED



ParentCONNECTxp (PCXP) is an easy-to-use online tool for communicating student progress that allows parents to take an even more active role in the education of their children. Parents and guardians of middle and high school students now have online, timely, and secure access to their children's grades and attendance

ParentCONNECTxp

through the ParentConnectxp portal site. Email alerts can also be set up to notify parents daily of absences, etc. Registration is free and must be done at the school a child attends. Access

to the site can be obtained through all school websites. Parents who had an account last year do not need to re-register.







School and school system messages, including emergency closings and delayed openings due to inclement weather, are communicated through a variety of avenues, including automated telephone messages. The phone numbers used for the Blackboard Connect (formerly Connect-ED) system are obtained from the student's school record and are provided by parents and/

or guardians. It is critically important that these numbers are kept updated with your child's school.

Parents and guardians can choose numbers to which they wish to have calls directed, and should contact their child's school if they wish to change the primary phone number.

The system also sends email messages containing information to parents and guardians. Please contact your child's school to ensure the correct email address is on file.

# The Nitty Gritty Details



- Safety: Students will be as distanced as possible (not consistently 3 feet)
- Masks- no gaiters, extras in the back-pack
- Illness: Cough, fever, sore throat, any cold-like symptom
- Quarantine: Positive Case: 10 days if within 3 feet for a cumulative 15 minutes
- Communication: Take Home Folders; Woody's World
- Free lunch and breakfast every day
- Snacks (please consider peanut free)
- Birthday celebrations (no food please)


