

Kindergarten Registration: 9:00am -12:30pm

Kindergarten registration begins on April 4th. Registration hours are 9:00<u>-12:30 pm daily</u>. Be sure to bring the following documentation, which are required to enroll:

- A copy of the child's birth certificate
- Immunization record
- Two proofs of residency--one must be a copy of lease or mortgage

Please spread the word to your neighbors and friends who have a child entering Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year. It is important to establish our Kindergarten numbers as soon as possible so that we can ensure we have enough teaching staff to provide a quality education. Kindergarten Orientation for students and parents is May 8th at 6:30 pm.






Hard Hat Zone
