WHO IS THE DANCE FOR?

WHAT DOES A FAMILY TICKET MEAN?

PBIS Celebration

Dear Jones Parents/Guardians

As part of our 3rd marking period PBIS celebration, students will be building instruments out of recyclable materials with their buddy classrooms. Recycled instruments can be made from anything that can be repurposed such as tissue boxes, different size rubber bands, coffee cans, plastic food containers, etc. To help facilitate this, we are asking students to bring in recyclables for their builds.

We will be creating the instruments on **Tuesday, April 9th**. Students may bring their materials in at any point leading up to the build day and store them in their classrooms.

Some ideas for types of instruments are:

- Tissue box guitar (String family)
- Coffee can drum (Percussion family)
- Paper towel roll rainmaker (Percussion family)
- Straw Panpipe (Woodwind family)
- Funnel and Tube (Brass family)

Some materials that can be used are:

- Empty paper towel OR toilet paper roll
- Empty coffee can OR Pringle can
- Plastic Bottles
- Yarn
- Old CD's
- Tissue paper
- Cardboard
- Rubber bands
- Empty tissue boxes
- Empty shoe boxes
- Dried beans OR rice in bags
- Beads

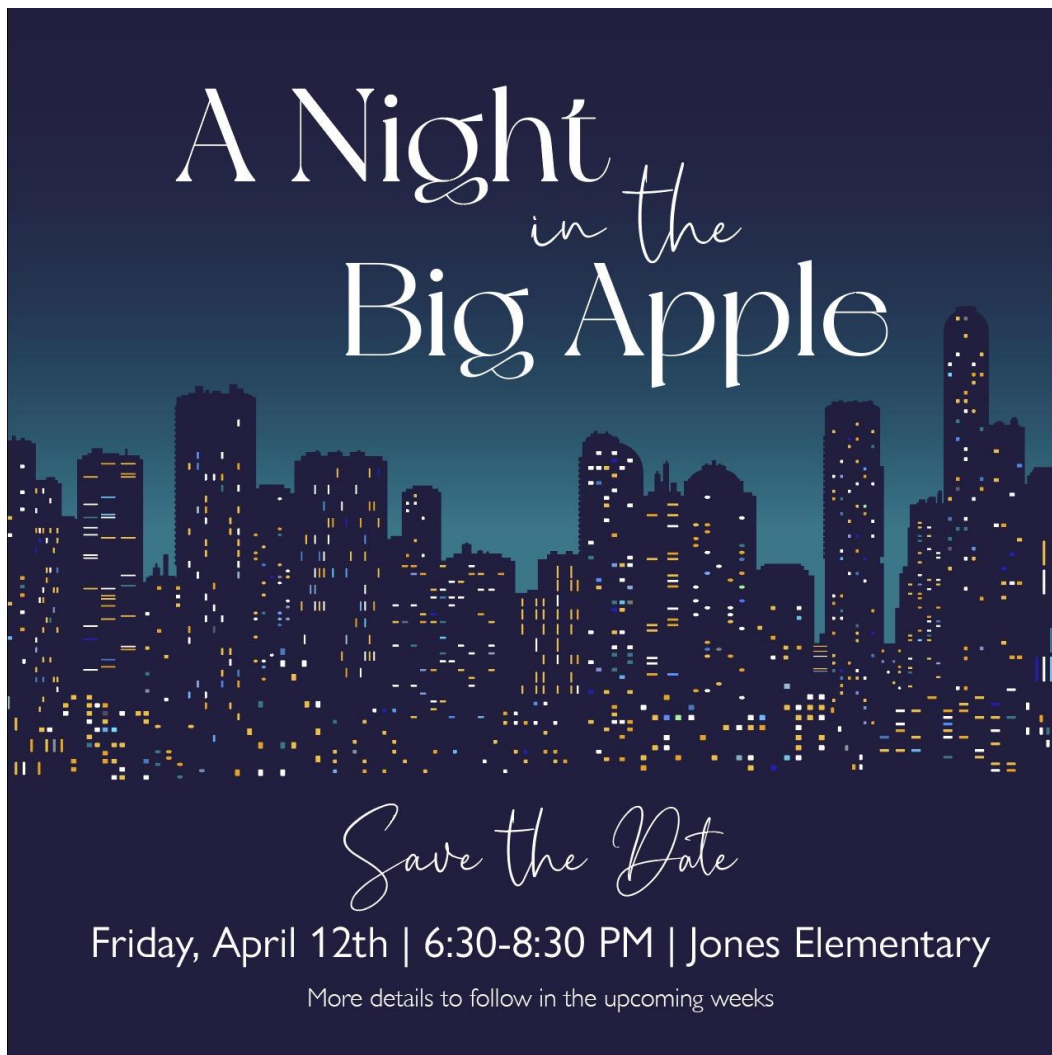

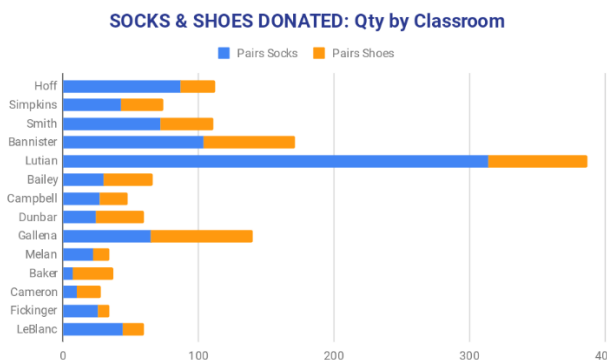
