FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE



- ◆ **ALL** visitors **MUST** sign-in at the office. This is a **MUST DO, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ◆ Your driver's license/government issued ID will be scanned and a ID badge will be issued to be worn while in the school.
