As in years past, we will continue to emphasize our school-wide expectations, to be respectful, to be responsible, and to be safe. These three expectations are the cornerstone of our school culture and climate as they hold all members of our school community accountable for their actions. The three expectations hold all members of our school community accountable to contribute to a consistently positive school environment.

This year as a school community we are making a concentrated and united effort to improve our school's overall student attendance rate. Last school year, Marley Elementary's chronic absentee rate was 35%. A student is considered chronically absent if the student misses 10% or more of the school year. 10% of the school years equals 18 school days.

As a school community, we will implement a plan and incentives related to improving our school attendance rate. In the upcoming monthly newsletters, we will share information about our school's monthly attendance rate and the monthly attendance rate by grade level. Additionally, we are going to provide you with more snapshots of our curriculum which will provide you with a vision of the learning that occurs at our school. I am sure that with our unified efforts we can boost Marley's attendance rate!

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that we have an additional assistant principal joining the administrative team. Colleen Sedora joins the team with nearly three decades of experience in education. Mrs. Sedora has worked in special education at the school and central office levels within AACPS (Anne Arundel County Public Schools). To subscribe, you may provide an email address or a mobile number or both to subscribe by email and mobile number on the <u>Bus Notification Form</u>.



Its purpose is to ensure that ALL children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach at least proficiency on the State's academic achievement standards and assessments. Funds are used to support additional academic services, materials, personnel, professional development, and parent & family engagement opportunities.

Schools are selected based on the percentage of students who qualify for free and reduced meals. This data is used for many grants to distribute funds. Schools are ranked according to this percentage.

Title I offers many benefits to students in our school. These benefits include parent & family engagement workshops, staff development, supplemental materials of instruction, extended learning programs, and additional teachers and staff. Parents are given opportunities to articulate their needs and assist in spending the budget during the school year.




