Marley Elementary School has lunch pick up from 12:00 to 12:30 each day. Simply come to the front of the school and one of our amazing staff members will assist you.

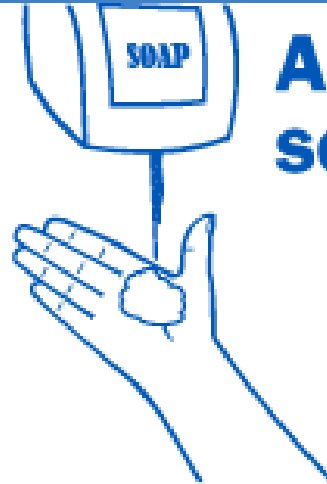

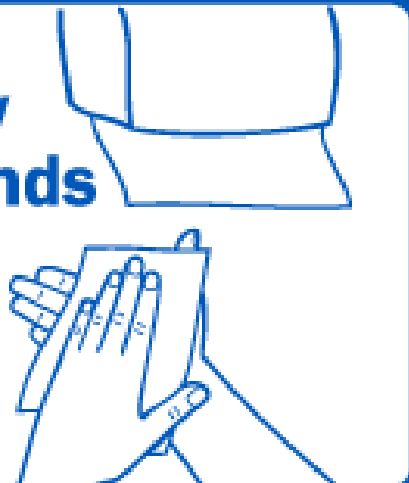
