- The school receives federal funding to support our students based on the percent of students who qualify for the free lunch program.
- All students fall under the Title I umbrella, and students are identified for intervention based on academic needs. Multiple data points are used to identify students for intervention.
- Title I funds are used to support student achievement, teacher professional development, and parent education.
- Title I personnel provide reading and math interventions by supplementing classroom instruction. The Title I resource personnel at MCES are:
 - 1. Title I Math Teacher
 - 2. Math Interventionist
 - 3. Title I Reading Teacher
 - 4. Reading Interventionist
 - 5. Title I Teaching Assistant
 - 6. Permanent Substitute
