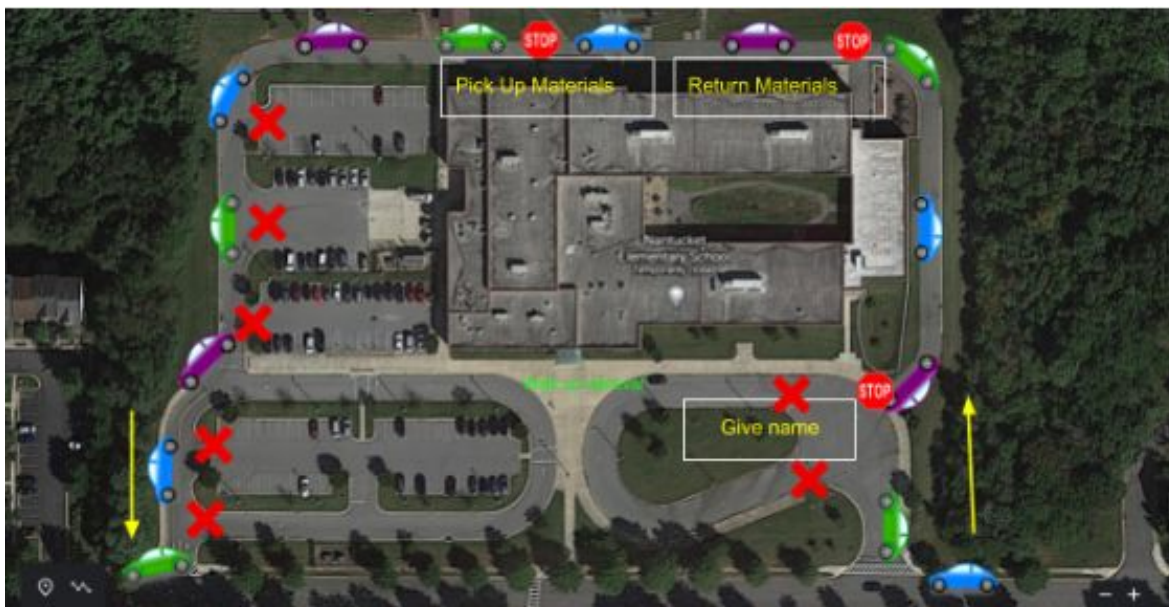
- To keep everyone safe and maintain social distancing, no students or parents will be allowed to enter the school building.
- All individuals on school property should be wearing a mask at all times.
- Teachers have collected each student's personal belongings from desks and lockers and placed them into labelled bags.
- These bags, as well as any musical instruments that need to be returned to students, have been alphabetized in the cafeteria/gymnasium.
- During this time, families will also return media books, textbooks, guided reading books, safety belts, and musical instruments (only if school owned and borrowed by 5th graders). If you borrowed a Chromebook and you are moving outside of Anne Arundel County, you will need to return your Chromebook and charger at this time.

The schedule for pickup at left is based on your last name. If your children have different last names, you can pick up at either time to limit your trips to school.

Our goal is for families to participate in a drive-thru to swap materials with us!

All parking lots at Nantucket will be blocked off to discourage parking. Parents coming to the school are encouraged to remain in their cars and use the drive-thru plan below. If you have your car rider hang tag or can write your student's last name on a paper, please display it in your car window to make the process as smooth as possible.



During your assigned time period,

1. Enter the bus loop and stay in your car. Follow the directions of Nantucket staff.
2. At the first stop you are going to relay your student's name to the Nantucket staff member.
3. At the second stop sign you are going to place any materials you need to return to Nantucket in a laundry basket provided by the school.
4. At the third stop sign, Nantucket staff members will bring all student belongings out to your car.
5. Finally, you may proceed around the access road and off of school property.

If you must walk to school to gather your belongings,

1. Bring the items you need to return to school with you toward the front door.
2. Follow social distancing and directions of Nantucket staff members.
3. At the table, provide your student's name to the staff member on duty.
4. Return any school materials in the provided laundry basket.
5. Move to the second table and collect your student's belongings.
