Dear Severna Park Families,

This first week in May is Teacher Appreciation Week! I am full of complete gratitude to our teachers. While riding the wave this year, teachers have transformed their classrooms several times and have been incredibly dedicated to providing the best education for our students. Please join me in thanking our SPES teachers!

Many families recently completed the Return To School survey. We know that many, many students and families want children back in the building for four days a week. We want you here full time, too! Keep in mind that this change may amount to about 10 extra days in the building, and we are on track for a full return to five days a week in the fall.

Unfortunately, with nearly 80% of our students back in the building for hybrid learning, we have limited seats and will only be able to accommodate a small number of students for the four-day model. Remember that the survey form was a **request**, not a guarantee.

There are several factors that will impact how many students are able to return to the building. There continues to be a limit on how many students in each class, even with the new CDC guidelines of 3 feet of social distancing. We must still plan for 6 feet of distancing because of the unmasked lunch breaks. In addition, there are staffing limitations, such as a lack of midday monitors and teaching staff availability due to accommodations (the nature of which is confidential).

Families will be notified of the status of their request as soon as we have information available. Any child who is coming back for the four-day model or any child moving from virtual to hybrid instruction will be invited to begin on or around May 13th. We look forward to seeing everyone back in the building in the fall!

A final kudos to the PTA who hosted a spectacular Disney Trivia Night and organized opportunities for our families to purchase SPES spirit wear. Thank you for your continued support!
