Trusted adults provide students with an opportunity to practice handling situations related to substance abuse, so that the first time a young person is faced with an unsafe situation, he or she knows what to do and has practiced doing it. Students will identify trusted adults, both inside and outside of the school, who they can go to for help. 

Kindergarten & First Grade Families

We are pleased to share that, as part of our commitment to early literacy and in conjunction with requirements of MD Senate Bill 734, Anne Arundel County Public Schools is implementing a screener to help identify students who are at risk for reading difficulties.

Between Monday, November 30 and Friday, December 18, Literacy Teachers at your school will individually screen each Kindergarten and First Grader using the DIBELS 8th Edition Assessment.

The assessment will last 15 minutes at most. Schools will communicate the results of the screener to each parent or guardian in January.

Shady Side Students have been busy in our weekly music classes! In Kindergarten, we are working with rhythm patterns, moving to music, and recognizing high and low pitch. First grade is exploring form and patterns in music and reading and writing rhythms. Second graders are reading rhythms and performing ostinatos or repeated musical patterns. Third graders are working with phrases and form and will soon begin reading more complex sixteenth-note rhythms. Fourth graders have worked with concepts such as harmony and melody by composing using the Chrome Music Lab website. 5th Grade is about to begin their third project, a "Musical Timeline" focusing on a year of their life through music. Although we will not have homework assignments in Music Class, any graded classwork (denoted by a star) that has not been turned in during the allotted class time, will need to be completed. Please help your child check their "To Do List" to see if they have any missing assignments. Our Chorus students are working on their vocal skills as they prepare their song, "Ringin Ringin" in preparation for our Winter "Virtual Choir" showcase. As a reminder, 4th Grade Chorus meets Mondays at 11:20 and 5th Grade Chorus meets Fridays at 11:20. In addition, I am asking that Chorus students work on their song at least 3 times per week! I am looking forward to another fun-filled month of music making with our Shady Side students!

Band and Strings- Dr. Orr

The instrumental music classes at Shady Side Elementary School rock! I am so proud of our students for giving their best efforts in the instrumental virtual classroom. Additionally, I want to thank you, our grown-ups, for your continued support and patience as we navigate instrumental music in the virtual world.

I would like to share some upcoming additions to instrumental music classes. First, the intermediate and advanced band and orchestra now have ensemble practices. Orchestra and band students form bonds with their peers that may last a lifetime, and I want our students to have the opportunity to play music with their peers from other classes. Orchestra Ensemble meets on Tuesdays at 2:30 p.m. and Band Ensemble meets on Thursdays at 2:30 p.m. These ensembles are optional, but so important for musicianship development. The third marking period will bring the addition of Beginning Orchestra Ensemble and Beginning Band Ensemble.

Additionally, although nothing can replace a live concert, I will create a 2020-2021 Winter Instrumental Extravaganza video to highlight our marvelous musicians. During the coming week, I will post in your child's instrumental Google Classroom a [Google Form](#) that needs to be completed with your help. This form authorizes me permission to include your child's MP3 or MP4 in the video. Although each child will be required to provide an assessment recording, families may opt out of including the recording in the presentation video. Because of copyright restrictions, this video will only be shared in the instrumental Google Classrooms. I kindly ask families to refrain from downloading the video, as the Music Office has warned that other school districts have suffered consequences because of copyright violations that have arisen from non-payment of royalties for recordings shared outside of the classroom setting.

I want to remind families to take advantage of make-up classes. In the virtual world, the show must go on, and schedule changes have not occurred to maintain consistency for the students. Make-up classes may be used for a missed class, extra help, holiday/early release missed classes and "I love music and can't get enough of Dr. Orr". Additionally, students may attend a different instrument's class within the same level. For instance, an advanced violin player could attend an advanced viola class.

Finally, starting Tuesday, November 16, 2020, and continuing every Tuesday and Thursday at 12:30 p.m., I will be online in a Google Meet for tuning assistance for string instruments. The Google Meet will appear every Tuesday and Thursday in the orchestra Google Classrooms.

As we enter the holiday season, I hope that you experience happiness and health. If you have any questions or concerns, I am only an email away.




