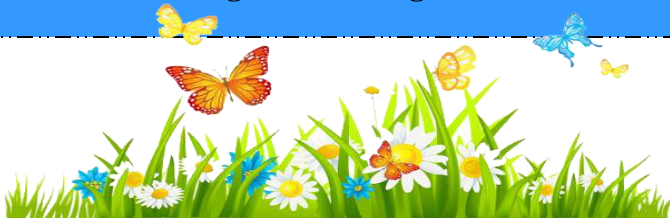

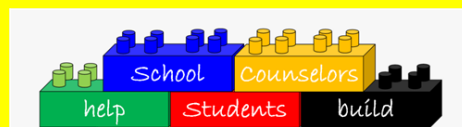


### Guidance News Ms. Blandford

May will usher in some very exciting units for our students at Shady Side!

Valerie Branch will join our 2nd grade classes for a virtual dance residency. Each class will meet with Ms. Branch during four classes in May and the beginning of June. We look forward to welcoming Ms. Branch and learning about movement and expression through her engaging residency.

Mrs. Kochanski's PreK and Kindergarten students are continuing to explore sound in a unit called *Let's Make Some Noise*. All first graders are exploring improvisation in various art forms.

Mrs. W-S's Kindergarten students are learning all about museums, curating museum collections, and even creating their own Museum of Very Small Things. This unit will continue through mid-May. Grown-ups are asked to please take a photo of their kindergartner's Museum and email it to Mrs. W-S along with the student's name and homeroom teacher. A slide presentation of all the museums will be shared at the culmination of the unit.

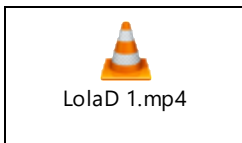

Hello families! I hope you and your loved ones are able to enjoy the glimpses of nicer weather. As the weather warms up, it is crucial that your children get outside for active play. Children should get 60 minutes of physical activity every day! Since our students are spending most of their day on the computer, physical activity is even more important. ## Music News – Mrs. Witmer

Hello Shady Side Families! It is hard to believe we are in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of the school year! Although Music Class looked quite different this year, I have enjoyed our time spent creating and learning about music! This month, Kindergarten will work on performing rhythms from sight and also explore AB form and instruments. First grade will identify and use their four voice types as well as learn a new rhythmic value: the half note. Second grade will read and sing with a solfege syllables and hand signs as well as learn about instrument families of the orchestra. In Third grade, we will identify Major and Minor tonality and explore expressive elements such as tempo and articulation. Fourth grade students will study Introduction and Coda and learn about the instruments and music of Band and Orchestra ensembles. Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade students have begun a new project where they will design a Musical Theme Park complete with short melodies to accompany each attraction. I am really excited to see what they create!

In Chorus this month, we will continue working on our song for our “Virtual Performance” and explore stage presence in the virtual setting. Additionally, there are two solo opportunities for our song. If you child is interested, I will have him or her submit a short video in the coming weeks! If your child is enrolled in Chorus, please ensure they attend our weekly Meet: Mondays at 1:40 p.m.

## Instrumental News – Dr. Orr

Instrumental musicians spring into May by exploring the many facets of music. The Advanced Band will explore musical concepts including the crescendo, diminuendo and the keys of Ab and Eb. Additionally, they will learn about the life and times of Elger, Gliere, and Tchaikovsky. The Beginning Band will play their first concert piece, “Eagle Summit March” and explore the musical concepts of vivace, mezzo forte and mezzo piano. The Beginning Orchestra will add the second tetrachord, G Down Tetrachord, and has learned the D major scale. They will continue to practice proper bow placement, reinforcing of the bow hold. Additionally, they will explore the octave “Ds,” first and second ending, and the ensemble pieces, “Obsiwanta” and “Grand Canyon Waltz.” The Intermediate Orchestra will discover staccato, legato, dotted quarter note, and bow divisions. Additionally, they will explore the life and times of Dvorak. Finally, the Advanced Orchestra will dive into C Down Tetrachord, ritardando, and the ensemble pieces “Copy Cat,” “Grandma’s Song II” and “Frist Concert Piece.” The band and orchestra are ready to make May Marvelous!

As the instrumental department enters the final countdown to the end of the year, families and students need to know the timeline. Students will once again be presenting their skills in an end of the year presentation. Instrumental students will record one song of their choice to highlight the growth in their musical skills over the school year. The deadline to submit the recording to Google Classroom is May 7, 2021. Students were informed of the presentation the week of April 21, 2021. The completed Instrumental Spring Recital will be available for viewing by families in your child’s instrumental Google Classroom the week of May 17, 2021. Please do not download or copy the video as those actions violate copyright laws. The week of May 24-28, 2021 will be filled with activities that do not require playing an instrument, so students may bring their school loaned instruments back to the school. Formal instrumental music instruction ends on Friday, May 28, 2021. Finally, all school instruments should be returned to Shady Side Elementary School by June 2, 2021, so they may be cleaned, repaired, and inventoried in preparation for the next school year.
