Monthly Curriculum Overview:

Reading: In reading, students will use the informational text, Computers to further develop their skills and knowledge of the following reading skills: multiple accounts, author's point and evidence, informational text structures, and drawing inferences.

Writing: Students will continue to analyze mentor texts and literature to identify the various components of memoirs and continue to work through the levels of developing their memoir.

<u>Math</u>: Currently, students are reviewing multiplication and division strategies for whole numbers. We will end the year graphing on a coordinate plane.

Science: Students will be studying the environment and how it is affected by natural and human changes. We will analyze relationships between human activities and the earth's resources. Studying the earth's water supply and its consumption and conservation will be this month's focus. The school year will end with a culminating research project.

Social Studies: We are studying the beginnings of our government, the Constitution, branches of the government, and individual's rights and responsibilities. The school year will end with a culminating research project.

Health: In health, students will continue to further develop their knowledge of creating a healthy social and emotional environment for themselves and those around them. Specifically, lessons this marking period will focus on self-management.
