Principal's Message...

Hello Shady Side Families,



While this is not "school as usual", each day of online learning is part of our school year, and students are engaging with content that will prepare them for the reopening of school, whenever that will be. Teachers are also determining achievement levels for fourth quarter report cards based on the items indicated as "Graded" in Google Classroom. It is important for students to engage in the learning opportunities and complete all assignments – whether this be day by day or whenever possible by the Sunday due date. We understand not everyone is available to go live during our learning time and office hours, but we also know our students, especially at the intermediate grades, have the skills to do much of this on their own.

Without the normal classroom opportunities for teachers to provide practice and monitor student acquisition of skills, the submission of practice activities becomes even more important. These allow teachers to provide feedback to help students grow as well as determine what support sessions and enrichment opportunities students need in order to progress to their greatest extent. The support of parents and guardians is certainly essential to our students' success, but it is equally important that all work submitted be reflective of what our students can do independently so that teachers can meet their needs.

We may be temporarily divided by space, but we continue to be united in purpose. The Shady Side Elementary School community is strong, capable, and continuing to amaze. The end of online learning is still unknown, but we are committed to supporting our scholars to help them achieve at high levels regardless of the format in which learning takes place.

Please let your children know how much I miss seeing them, talking to them, and working with them each day.

In the past few weeks, I have had many students participating in some of the guidance activities that I have posted in my classroom. I'd love to see more students participating in the upcoming weeks. Originally, I started out with a classroom for each grade level, but as time went on, School Counselors were directed to consolidate to one classroom.
