## Prekindergarten Application—Important Information

### In order to enroll your child into Prekindergarten:

- Children must be four years of age on or before September 1st of the school year in which they are registering.
- Children must reside in Anne Arundel County.
- Public school prekindergarten programs in Maryland must serve children from economically disadvantaged or homeless families.
- If seats remain after all economically disadvantaged children have been enrolled, the system may enroll children who have other school readiness needs.

- Beginning February 6, 2019, applications for prekindergarten will be accepted at all prekindergarten program sites.
- Contact your local school for information about office hours. Information about individual school programs is available at [www.aacps.org](http://www.aacps.org).
- You will need to bring the following documents with you when you apply:
  - Documentation of income eligibility for Category 1 applicants only:
    - *Most recent Federal Income Tax Return (1040) or*
    - *A current Food Stamp Award Letter or*
    - *A current Temporary Cash Assistance Award Letter or*
    - *Proof of Foster Care Income*
  - Your child's original birth certificate
  - A copy of your child's immunization record (Check immunization requirements at [www.cdc.gov/vaccines/](http://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/))
  - Proof of residency in Anne Arundel County
    - *Lease/mortgage document and a current telephone bill or utility bill or income tax/property tax notice or*
    - *A notarized Tenant Verification Form (available at all schools)*

**Note: Homeless students have the right to enroll immediately**

**A current Federal Income Tax Return (1040) is required for Head Start enrollment**

## Solicitud de Ingreso de Preescolar—Información Importante

A partir del 5 de febrero de 2020 las solicitudes para el pre kínder serán aceptadas en todos los sitios con programas de pre kínder.

**Nota:** Los programas de preescolar en escuelas públicas de Maryland deben ofrecer sus servicios a niños de familias de bajos recursos o sin hogar. Si quedan vacantes después de inscribir a todos los niños de bajos recursos, el sistema podrá inscribir a niños con otras necesidades de recibir preparación para la escuela.

### Requisitos de Edad y Residencia

- Los niños deben tener cuatro años de edad el 1 de septiembre o antes del año escolar en que los están inscribiendo.
- Los niños deben vivir en el Condado de Anne Arundel.

**Para inscribir a su hijo en Preescolar:** Necesita traer los siguientes documentos para hacer la solicitud:

- Documentación únicamente para los solicitantes con elegibilidad de ingresos para la categoría 1:
  - La más reciente *Declaración de Impuestos Federales (1040)*
  - *Carta de otorgamiento actual de cupones de alimentos*
  - *Carta de otorgamiento actual de asistencia temporal con dinero en efectivo*
  - *Comprobante de ingresos por cuidado de crianza*
- El certificado de nacimiento original de su hijo/niño
- Una copia del registro de vacunas de su hijo/niño (vea los requisitos de vacunas en <http://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/>)
- Comprobante de domicilio en el Condado de Anne Arundel
  - *Documento de alquiler/hipoteca y una cuenta actual de teléfono o servicio público o notificación de impuestos a la renta/impuestos sobre la propiedad*
  - *Un formulario de verificación de inquilino certificado por un notario (disponible en todas las escuelas)*

### Estudiantes sin Vivienda

Los estudiantes sin vivienda tienen derecho a inscribirse de inmediato.

### Head Start

Para inscribirse en el programa Headstart es necesario presentar la declaración de impuestos federales (1040) más reciente.
