Here is some important information as we embark on this very exciting new journey:

- Teachers will be reaching out to all students to reconnect with them and to provide some practice opportunities that will get them familiar with the Google Suite that they will be using for e-learning. Please note, no activities that have been posted already or the activities next week will be graded. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a Google Meet, post and respond in Google Classroom, and interact with their teacher virtually.
- Assignments will be graded starting April 14<sup>th</sup>. Teachers will be identifying which assignments are graded and which are not graded.

- Other resources like French, morning announcements, inquiry opportunities, and other school spirit opportunities will be coming soon, so be on the lookout.
