SIGN UP TO RECEIVE EMAIL/TEXT ALERTS OF BUS ROUTE IMPACTS

As part of our ongoing effort to keep families and the community updated on impacts to bus route operations, Anne Arundel County Public Schools offers email and text message notifications of disruptions to student bus service.

To subscribe to that free service, log on to www.aacps.org/busnotifications.

The system provides email and text message notifications in either English or Spanish to those who register. Users are asked to provide the bus number and school for which they wish to receive the notification.

Users can sign up to receive multiple notifications and will be asked to confirm registrations through the email address or phone number they utilize. One registration will need to be done for each bus/school combination.






