



Kindergarten Registration begins April 3,2024 for the 2024-2025 School Year

Documents must be in jpg or pdg format when uploading

Eligibility Requirements

Child must be 5 years old by September 1,2024

You will need the following items to begin the registration

- *Birth Certificate
- *Immunization Records (to date)
- * Two proofs of address:
 - One must be your current lease or mortgage statement.
 - Second should be a current utility bill.
- *Parent Identification
- * Any Custody Agreement (if applicable)
- *Physical Form (within the past 9 months)

Our kindergarten orientation will be held on Thursday, May 23, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. You will meet the administration team and our kindergarten teachers. You will learn about the expectations and routines here at Southgate, as well as a sample day in the life of a kindergartener. Your incoming kindergartener is welcome to attend with you, but no siblings, please. We hope to see you there.


