

What's Different In Middle School?

- Each class is 50 minutes long with 4 minutes between each class.
- Lunch is 30 minutes long.
- Every student will be assigned to a "team." For questions, concerns or to schedule a conference



- •The grades earned in these courses will be on your high school transcript.








- Bus Riders will be dismissed first at 4:05 pm

Mr. Kelly's Keys To Academic Success at OMMN



- 1. Use your agenda each day homework, due dates, and reminders.
- 2. Stay organized binders, locker, and homework area
- 3. Complete your homework (and hand it in with your name on it!)
- 4. Create a homework study area and routine at home. Routines are de-stressors and reduce anxiety.
- 5. Participate in after-school help and perhaps a club.
- 6. Identify your resources inside and outside of the building. Use them.
- 7. Balance school and outside sporting or social activities.
- 8. Make sure your child gets enough sleep and down time.

Student Dress Code

- The Middle School Dress Code is in place to minimize disruptions to the educational program.
- If there is a dress code violation, a change of clothes will need to be made.

Required Uniforms
