

Dear Parents/Guardians:

If your child received an "NG" for any class in the fourth marking period, we invite your child to participate in a unique program this summer. The Secondary Summer "NG Assignment Recovery" Program is designed for secondary students who received a "No Grade – NG" status in the fourth quarter but still earned a B, C, or D as a final grade. Through drop-in, teacher-led tutoring sessions, students will complete and submit required assignments, resulting in increased learning and grade improvement. Successful completion of assignments will allow students to replace the "No Grade - NG" status with a "Satisfactory – S" status, thus earning a higher final grade on their middle school transcript. Estimados padres/tutores:

Si su estudiante recibió un grado de "NG" para cualquier clase en el cuarto período de calificaciones, invitamos a su estudiante a participar en un programa especial este verano. El Programa de Verano "Recuperación de Asignaciones de NG" está diseñado para estudiantes de las escuelas intermedias que recibieron una calificación de "Sin grado – NG" en el cuarto trimestre, pero que todavía obtuvieron una B, C o D como grado final. A través de sesiones de tutoría dirigidas por los maestros, los estudiantes completarán y presentarán las tareas requeridas, lo que resulta en un mayor aprendizaje y mejora de los grados. La finalización exitosa de las tareas permitirá a los estudiantes reemplazar la calificación de "Sin Grado - NG" por una calificación de "Satisfactorio – S", obteniendo así una calificación final más alta en su transcripción de la escuela intermedia. Promotion of Students

Middle School

- a. In order for a middle school student to be promoted to Grade 7, he/she must pass three of four Core courses (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies). In addition, if a student takes fewer than five Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than one Encore course. If a student takes five or more Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than two Encore courses.

- b. In order for a middle school student to be promoted to Grade 8, he/she must pass three of four Core courses (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies). If a Core course is failed, it must not be in the same subject failed in a previous year. In addition, if a student takes fewer than five Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than one Encore course. If a student takes five or more Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than two Encore courses.

- c. In order for a middle school student to be promoted to Grade 9, he/she must pass three of four Core courses (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies). If a Core course is failed, it must not be in the same subject failed in a previous year. In addition, if a student takes fewer than five Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than one Encore course. If a student takes five or more Encore courses, he/she may fail no more than two Encore courses.
