

The AVID Tutor

AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination) is a college readiness system for elementary through higher education that is designed to increase school wide learning and performance. The AVID College Readiness System (ACRS) accelerates student learning, uses research based methods of effective instruction, provides meaningful and motivational professional learning, and acts as a catalyst for systematic reform and change. Students in the AVID elective class participate in tutorials on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. They are required to bring a question from one of their core classes that they may be struggling or having difficulty with to each tutorial. During the tutorials, students are put into groups, and with the guidance of the tutors, receive help from their peers and tutor with their point of confusion. The goal of the AVID tutorial is to "create rigorous tutorials to increase student achievement in academic classes."

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

These examples are illustrative and are not all inclusive.

- 1. Complete AVID tutor training initial and on-going
- 2. Facilitate the tutorial learning process and implement AVID methodologies
- 3. Actively participate in maintaining their AVID binders(with calendar, assignment sheets, Tutorial Request Forms and daily Cornell notes in all academic classes)
- 4. Actively facilitate collaborative groups and tutorial sessions
- 5. Ensures ongoing communication with schools to support continuous tutorial improvement
- 6. Assists students with higher level thinking by modeling questioning
- 7. Become familiar with the specific routines and expectations of the AVID classroom
- 8. Adhere to district/site policies and procedures
- 9. Performs other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Full time enrollment in a four-year college or university
- 2. Excellent oral and written communication
- 3. Strong interpersonal and organizational skills
- 4. Positive and professional mentoring habits
- 5. Desire to actively work with middle level students
- 6. Commitment to a schedule is necessary
