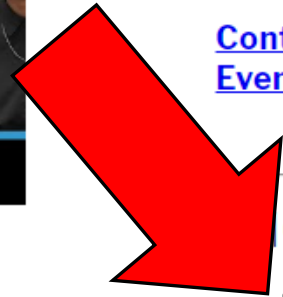

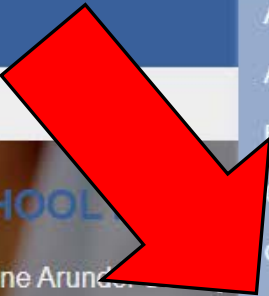




**ONLINE SCHOOL**

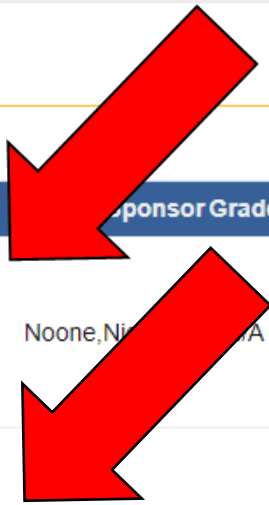





**English 4:** 1 credit in English 9 1 credit in English 10 1 credit in English 11 1 credit in English 12

**Social Studies 3:** 1 credit in History of the United States 1 credit in World History 1 credit in United States Government

**Mathematics 4\*:** 1 credit in Algebra 1 1 credit in Geometry 2 mathematics elective credits (\*Algebra 2 for college completers)

**Science 3+:** 1 credit in Biology 2 credits, including laboratory experience, in any or all of the following areas: • Earth Science • Life Science • Physical Science Physical Education 1 0.5 credit of Fitness for Life 0.5 credit

**Physical Education Elective** 1 credit


**Health 0.5:** 0.5 credit in Health Education

**Basic Technology 1:** Foundations of Technology A (0.5 credit) and Foundations of Technology B (0.5 credit) or one of the following one credit courses available at Project Lead the Way schools only: Honors Principles of Engineering or Honors Engineering Design

**Fine Arts 1:** Music, Art, Dance, and Theatre Arts courses

**Electives 8.5:** Any electives that result in the successful completion of a Completer Program Pathway Students who entered high school in 2014–15 or later are required to take a rigorous math course each of the four years the student is enrolled.
