Assessments Evidence of Learning  Teachers must use Google Classroom & Google Meet	<ul> <li>There will be one graded assessment/assignment each week</li> <li>Teachers grade and record assessments/assignments according to a rubric created by the Academic Team</li> <li>Teachers will grade all 9 pre-determined assessments/assignments during the marking period</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>There will be one graded assessment/assignment each week</li> <li>Some courses may require a few assessments/assessments that have been predetermined by the Academics Team</li> <li>In most courses, teachers will create at least 4 out of 9 graded assessments/assignments during the marking period</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>There will be one graded assessment/assignment each week</li> <li>Teachers will develop, administer, and grade all assessments/assignments</li> <li>Teachers will create and grade 9 assessments/assignments out of during the marking period</li> </ul>
