






Question 4: How many students do you have in Anne Arundel County Public School who you will be seeking daycare for in the fall?




Question 5: What do you feel are the top 3 priorities AACPS needs to focus on as they prepare to reopen?






Question 7: Which of the following are the most important factors when deciding which schooling model is best for you as an AACPS employee?






Question 9: As we prepare for the fall and the transition to more synchronous teaching, which additional training or professional development do you fell would benefit you the most?




Question 10: How valuable was Google Voice in communicating with parents, students, office staff, division members, etc.?




Question 11: What types of devices do you have to support you doing your work from your home?




Question 12: Which people did you most depend on the help you with technological problems?



Question 13: Do you have access to reliable internet service in your home to support online synchronous teaching, counseling, coaching, tutoring, or virtual meeting through teleconferencing?




Question 14: Please indicate the internet service provider in your home.




Question 15: How has time for relationships with colleagues changes during this pandemic?



Question 16: How has the quality of working with colleagues changed during this pandemic?




