# **SPORTSMANSHIP**

### What is Sportsmanship?

- The commitment to fair play, ethical behavior, and integrity (NFHS).
- The ability to maintain composure and continue to be respectful of student-athletes, coaches, officials, and other staff in tense and competitive environments.

- Because it teaches life lessons such as character, teamwork, and overcoming adversity.
- Because maintaining it especially in challenging times sets a standard for how we all want and deserve to be treated.

<ul> <li>I set the example as a leader of our program through my interactions with all stakeholders.</li> <li>I set clear expectations for my coaching staff and develop a process for them to communicate with me regarding concerns they have.</li> <li>I recognize exemplary behavior and actively discourage undesirable conduct by participants, coaches, and fans.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>I mentally prepare myself for interactions with officials in advance of contests and remember that my actions set the tone for my team.</li> <li>I talk with families about how they can display good sportsmanship as spectators.</li> <li>I respect the judgment of contest officials, abide by rules of the event and display no behavior that could incite fans.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>I seriously accept the responsibility and privilege of representing my school and community; display positive public actions at all times.</li> <li>I focus on what I can control and let go of what I can't.</li> <li>When on the sidelines I stay engaged with the contest in positive ways by cheering on my teammates and not antagonizing my opponents or the officials.</li> </ul>

# **BUILDING INCLUSIVE TEAM CULTURES**

- Because we value differences and believe teams are stronger when they are educated on those differences and take the time to celebrate them.
